Subject : Constitution of UT Level, Divisional and District Level Committees in UT of Ladakh for Border Development and Border Management.

Reference: D.O. No 1/17/2026-BM-II dated 06-08-2026, the Union Home Secretary, GoI.

In pursuance of the directions contained in the communication cited above and with the objective of strengthening border security, border management, inter-agency coordination and governance in the border areas of the Union Territory of Ladakh, sanction is hereby accorded to the constitution of the following **three levels of Committees under the UT Administration**, alongwith Terms of Reference as prescribed by MHA forming part of the prescribed **four-tier monitoring mechanism**, the fourth tier being the Apex Border Level Review Committee under the chairmanship of Union Home Secretary as under:

STAGE-I

District Level Border Issues & Action Committee (BIAC)

The Committee may co-opt representatives of other concerned departments/agencies whenever considered necessary.

Terms of Reference

The District Level BIAC shall:

1. undertake collection, collation and analysis of data relating to border issues;
2. identify trans-border crime and other border-related hotspots;
3. review emerging trends, patterns and modus operandi;

4. initiate appropriate preventive and corrective action;
5. prepare district-level action plans and monitor their implementation; and
6. place actionable issues requiring higher-level intervention before the appropriate higher Committee.

The Committee shall meet **monthly** and maintain a record of decisions/action points for submission to the Stage-II Committee.

Terms of Reference

The Divisional Review Committee shall:

1. review the actionable points emerging from the District Level BIAC;
2. monitor progress of action taken on such points;
3. identify issues requiring inter-district or inter-departmental coordination;
4. resolve issues within its competence; and
5. refer unresolved or UT-level issues, along with specific recommendations, to the Stage-II B UT Level Review and Monitoring Committee.

The Committee shall meet **monthly**.

The Chairperson may invite representatives of other Central Government agencies, Ministries/Departments, UT Departments or security agencies, as may be considered necessary for consideration of specific issues.

Terms of Reference

The UT Level RMC shall:

1. review and monitor the actionable points emanating from the District Level BIAC and Divisional Review Committee;
2. examine issues requiring UT-level policy intervention or inter-departmental coordination;
3. formulate appropriate UT-level strategies/policies to address border-related issues;
4. coordinate with UT line departments, Central Government agencies, Ministries/Departments and security agencies;
5. monitor implementation of decisions and action plans;
6. identify issues requiring intervention at the level of the Government of India; and
7. submit regular **Action Taken Reports (ATRs)** and proposals requiring higher-level intervention to the Ministry of Home Affairs.

The Committee shall meet **quarterly**.

Nodal Arrangement

The **Home Department, UT of Ladakh** shall function as the nodal department for coordination, consolidation of reports and placing of matters before the UT Level Review and Monitoring Committee and, wherever required, before the Ministry of Home Affairs.

Effective Date

The above monitoring mechanism shall come into force with immediate effect.
