Para Legal Volunteer (PLV)

Who is a Para Legal Volunteer (PLV)

PLV act as an intermediary for bridging the gap between common people and the Legal Services Institutions to remove impediments in "Access to Justice".

Who can be a PLV

- Teachers (including retired teachers), Retired Government servants and senior citizens.
- Anganwadi Workers, Members of non-political, service oriented NGOs and Clubs.
- Doctors/Physicians.
- Students & Law Students (till they enroll as lawyers).
- Members of Women Neighbourhood Groups, Maithri Sanghams and other Self Help Groups including of marginalized/vulnerable groups.
- Educated prisoners with good behaviour, serving long term sentences in prisons.

Educational Qualification to be a PLV

Literate person, preferably matriculate, with a capacity for overall comprehension.

Benefits of becoming a PLV

- Opportunity to contribute towards the Society effectively.
- PLVs are paid honorarium between 600/- to 1800/- for legal service work.
