2.	Sugamya Sahayak Scheme (to facilitate mobility & capability of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities. The objective of the scheme is to enhance and empower the mobility of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities in their daily lives by providing durable and standardized quality of Aids and Appliances to Persons with Benchmark Disabilities).	<p>1. The applicant must be a Person with Benchmark Disability (40% or more disability) as per Disability Certificate/UDID Card.</p> <p>2. Must be resident of NCT of Delhi.</p> <p>3. The annual income limit of the family from all sources should not be more than Rs.8,00,000/-</p> <p>4. Possession of Aadhaar Card</p> <p>5. The applicant should not have obtained the same item from any other Govt. scheme during the last three (3) years. However, for children below 12 years of age, no limit would be applicable for appliances that are fabricated.</p>	Durable and standardized Aids and Appliances such as Wheelchair, Motorized Tricycle, Braille Kit, Hearing Aids, Crutches, Callipers, Walkers and Smart Phone etc. are distributed free of cost to Persons with Benchmark Disabilities through organizing camps in the districts of Department of Social Welfare, GNCTD. Through these camps total 347 beneficiaries were benefited out of which 169 were Children with Disabilities who received Aid & Devices.</p> <p>Total expenditure incurred worth Rs. 62,49,337/- out of which approx.
