The objective of the Internship Program is to provide first-hand experience of day-to-day operations of the Authority by closely working at grass root level of our Society as well as hands on experience on legal issues faced by people at large. This is a unique opportunity to see the working of Free Legal Aid System and different stakeholders with each other to ensure that the awareness of various welfare scheme of Government as well as that of functioning of DSLISA/NALSA to reach the marginalized sections of the society.

We invite motivated law students who take initiative and have zeal to work for the marginalized sections of the society to join hands with us. We welcome students who are socially active, have a positive attitude and empathy to work for different sections of the society.

Who can apply:

Law students pursuing Five years Course and Three Years Course are eligible to apply for this program.

Skills required:

Efficiency in written Communication (English), Legal writing, Basic legal knowledge, Computer Operation in Word/Excel/PPT.

Timeline:

- **1st May, 2026 (From 10:00 AM onwards)**

Students can apply online for Summer Internship programme-2026 through DSLSA's official website i.e. www.dslsa.org.

- **15th May, 2026 (Till 5:00 PM)**

Last date for submission of applications. Application should be submitted with passport size photograph of the applicant alongwith recommendation letter issued by principal/HOD of Law Department. In case desired documents are not attached, then application will not be considered.

- **20th May, 2026**

Students will be selected by following appropriate criteria, if more than required applications are received. The shortlisted students will be informed about the same via e-mail.

- **23rd May, 2026 (Last Date for sending confirmation)**

Students shall be required to send a confirmation e-mail @ legallitwing-dslsa@nic.in of their participation in Internship Program positively latest by 23rd May, 2026, failing which their application is liable to be rejected.

- **05th to 25th June, 2026**
