



Governor's Cup Golf Tournament-2024

: <u>Tournament Report</u> :

- 1. The 19th Governor's Cup Golf Tournament was conducted by RBGC under the supervision of the Executive Committee at Raj Bhawan Golf Club from 07-09 June 2024.
- 2. The main objectives of the tournament are as follows :-
 - A. To build awareness of the excellent golfing facilities at Raj Bhawan Golf Club, Nainital and enable it success to the golfers from all over the country and Students (Boys and Girls) in and around Nainital and Uttarakhand.
 - **B.** To further develop Uttarakhand as a Golf Tourism destination for domestic and international golfers under Khelo India Movement.

PARTICIPATION

- 3. Though 130 golfers had confirmed their participation. However later 123 golfers turned up for the tournament. Compared with the size of this par 61 course, this number and response of participants after the long break was particularly very good.
- 4. The golfers travelled from as far as the State of Kolkata and from the states of Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand.
- 5. Participations Indifferent Category are as Below:
 - a) Super Veterans (75 and above) : 06
 - b) Veterans (65-75yrs) : 19
 - c) General Category : 63
 - d) Ladies Category : 10
 - e) Jr. Golfers (15-18yrs) : 09
 - f) Jr. Golfers (12-15yrs) : 07
 - g) Jr. Golfers (Under12 Yrs) : 09
- 6. One Golfer came from USA Mr. Dev Pal Duggal, a member of Laurel Hill Golf Club.

- 7. The annual Inter Schools Golf Tournament has also been incorporated to this annual Governors Cup Golf Tournament in order to make use of this excellent facility available at Nainital, Uttarakhand.
- 8. It has been the basic policy of Hon'ble Governor Uttarakhand Lt Gen Gurmit Singh PVSM, UYSM, AVSM, VSM to give importance to both education and sports alike. It is felt that sports apart from giving a meaningful direction to energy of youth also contributes to building Leadership qualities through Outdoor Experiential Learning.
- 9. Hon'ble Governor has also expressed that due recognition be given to the Girl Child so as to bring awareness for the upliftment of Ladies and the Girl Child.
- 10. The Executive Committee of RBGC also directed that a coaching clinic was to be held for interested children from Schools in and around Nainital for a month and half in order to initiate school children below 17 years of age in the basics of golf. The coaching was to be given by Golf staff of RBGC under the supervision of Executive Committee of RBGC.
- It was also decided to give the coaching and facilities of golf equipment like clubs, balls and training aids at no cost basis to the participants and the schools.
- A total of 123 students from 09 school participated in the coaching clinic conducted by RBGC Staff. This included 20 girls from these schools.
- 13. The students were divided in to age wise categories as under:
 - a) Category A Under 12 yrs. Boys/Girls
 - **b**) Category B Under 12 to 15 yrs. Boys/Girls
 - c) Category C Under 15 to 17 yrs. Boys/Girls
- 14. The participants took very keen interest in the coaching clinic and it was seen that the young students picked up the basics of the game of golf to a reasonable level in the short duration of the clinic.
- 15. For the Final Tournament a Total of 40 students were shortlisted to play on 12 May, 2024.

Curtain Raiser / Press Meet

- 16. The Press meet was held on 06 June, 2024.
- 17. An impressive 12"x10" digitally printed backdrop showing RBGC logo along with the logos of Lead, Associate and Co-sponsors was prominently placed during the Press meet at Raj Bhawan Golf Club. Large numbers of press fraternity both print, electronic and digital media from local and national representatives from various channels were present.
- During the function, trophies, to be presented for the various events of the tournament, and Sponsor names were also displayed prominently. The curtain raiser report is attached at Appendix- B.

Conduct of the Tournament

- 19. Due to ground constraints and keeping in mind the safety of participants, caddies, supervisory staff viz marshals, referee and others the tournament was extended over three days to accommodate all the participants.
- 20. The tournament was played over 27 holes Stable ford and Stroke play with modified handicapping of the Peoria system.
- 21. On the first day, half the number of participants played 18 holes Stableford and on the second day the remaining participants played the same18 holes.
- A cut was applied on the third days o that the best golfers play on the final day. A total of
 40 players made the cut and these golfers played nine holes based on Stroke play format.
- 23. There were separate categories for ladies, Junior boys and girls below 18 years. Besides this there was a general category, veteran category and super veteran category for golfers 75 years and above.

ACCOMODATION

24. The summer in Nainital always coincides with the vacations and peak tourist season makes it difficult to get accommodation in local hotels. Raj Bhawan used their considerable good will to arrange accommodation at various places. Besides this, golfers were issued within formation well in advance so that they could directly book the accommodation as per their requirement.

MANAGEMENT

- 25. The Executive Committee of the Raj Bhawan Golf Club took it as a challenge to conduct and manage the tournament of this magnitude by its own staff. This being their personal venture, no stone was left unturned by them so as to make the event a rewarding success. Inspite of all odds the tournament was conducted smoothly and acclaimed whole hearted appreciation by all golfers..
- 26. The press gave good reviews about the Tournament and especially for the students coaching and their tournament.
- 27. Officers of Raj Bhawan, Dehradun and volunteers of RBGC were a great help in assisting us to this extent.



GIVE-AWAYS

29. RBGC has been very generous in distributing the giveaways to all the participants. Each golfer was given a Duffel Bag containing T-Shirt, golf cap with RBGC Logo, Sleeve of golf balls (Taylormade RBZ), Towel set, Golf Umbrella and Lapel pin of RBGC.

FIRST DAY'S PLAY

30. After the Inaugural Ceremonial Tee–off conducted by the Hon'ble Governor of Uttarakhand and President, RBGC, Lt Gen Gurmit Singh at 08.30 hrs, 62 golfers including, Super Veterans, Ladies and Juniors Teed-off for the first days play starting at 0830 hrs onwards. The last fourballs finished 18 holes by 1500 hrs.

SECOND DAY'S PLAY

31. 61 Golfers including ladies and juniors teed-off for the second days play starting from 06.30 hrs onwards. The second days play went off more smoothly after the initial dust had settled down. The Result of the first and second days play enabled the tournament committee to make the cut off for players to play on the final day. The draw of the players making the cut for final day was displayed at the venue of the Gala dinner as planned for all golfers and spouses. The players declared to play on the final day now enabled the participants to know how they have fared and plan their strategy for the final days play.

THIRD DAY'S PLAY

- 32. On the third day, 44 golfers including Ladies and Juniors making the cut were made to play 9 holes Stroke play. First Tee off was at 0700 hrs. It was an ideal day to play golf with a light blue sky mixed with some clouds and a mild breeze. All players finished 9 holes by 1300 hrs. Since enough time was available till the prize distribution ceremony to be held at 1600 hrs, the result could be compiled, checked and rechecked to avoid any controversy.
- 33. An IGU qualified Class A Referee was invited as part of the Tournament Committee to insure fair play and transparency in the tournament.

Prize Distribution Ceremony

- 34. The prize distribution ceremony took place at 1500 hrs in the Ball Room of Raj Bhawan.
 35. The ceremony commenced with on arrival of The First Lady of Uttarakhand Mrs. Gurmit Kaur who was kind enough to give the trophies to winners and the runners up. It was followed by a welcome address by the Golf Captain who also gave the tournament report.
- 36. Results were then announced.
- 37. After the prize distribution the First lady of Uttarakhand Mrs. Gurmit Kaur addressed the golf fraternity. Secretary to Governor & Senior Vice President, RBGC Shri Ravinath Raman, IAS give the relevance of Golf in the present world scenario where in it is no longer an entertainment sport for the rich but a professional sport as well. As also the Leadership qualities of golf were highlighted by him. Hon'ble Governor stated that we must encourage those golfers in the state who cannot afford to play this game as facilities exist for the same in the state of Uttarakhand.
- The ceremony concluded with a Vote of Thanks by the Secretary, RBGC Shri Amit Srivastava, IPS followed by National Anthem.
- 39. High Tea was laid in the main dining hall of Raj Bhawan. It was attended by the participants along with their family members to gather with the invitees and members of media.

Tournament Rules for Governor's Cup Golf Tournament-2024

Safety First : There are several crossing sections of the golf course. Play carefully.

Core Principal : "Play the course as you find it. Play the ball as it lies"

Format of Play :

1. "Handicap of the Day" to be Established based on the Single Preoria System on Day 1, 2 - whichwillbeinStablefordFormatover18 holes. Maximum Handicap of the Day is capped at 18.

2. Those making the cut in each category will play on the final day in a 9-hole Stroke Play format.

Completion of Hole :

1. **Stable Ford** : Pick-up the ball is more than2 over Paronany hole (Because there is no possibility of any Stable ford Point). Put 3+Par Value of Hole" on Scorecard.

2. Stroke Play : All holes must be played completely - there is no "given"

Pace of Play :

- i) Ready Golf to be played : those in position and able to play will make the stroke.
- ii) Ball search time is a maximum of three minutes.

Course Markings :

Fairways : Fairway edge is marked with white bricks. On the line is inside the fairway.

Penalty Relief: Ball outside fairway marking :-

1. Play as it is from rough.

2. Place the ball on the line with one penalty Stroke on fairway marking line (recommended). Not applicable if ball is lost / not found.

Penalty Areas : Red Penalty Area (Water body and this is also a "No" Play Zone) common to Hole No. 2, 7, 8 and back Hole No. (11,16,17)

Preferred Lie :

There is one club preferred lie (not nearer to the hole) within Fairway markers only.

Drop Zones (DZ) :

- Where provided, Drop Zones must be used if relief is taken (to aid the Pace of Play)
 A Penalty of one stroke will apply
- 2) Drop Zones are marked on Hole 1, 4, 5, 7, 8 and back nine (10, 13, 14, 16, 18).D Z may be, in some situations, closer to the hole.

No Play Zones :

- 1. Play is prohibited from these areas players are not permitted to enter or play, and will take mandatory penalty relief :-
- 2. Red penalty area (Water body on Hole no. 2,7,8 and Hole no 11, 16, 17)
- 3. Ditchonholeno7&16

Free Relief : Ball going inside fairways to near drains / Mud drains : take a free drop within 2 club lengths, no closer to the hole.

Tee-Off Timing and Late Comers :

- i) Players need to report on the tee at the designated times.
- ii) Late comers will be accommodated (if possible) at the discretion of the Tournament Committee with the next flight with a vacant slot.
- iii) In Stable Ford, 2 Strokes will be added to the first hole. In Stroke play, 2 strokes will be added to the Gross Total.

Play Can not be Completed :

If or any reason, play cannot be completed, the number of holes to be played/ to be counted will be decided by the Tournament Committee.

Use ful Extracts from the Rules of Golf, 2024 :

1. Maximum time to search for a ball is 3 minutes. If a ball is not found, the **ONLY** option is to replay the stroke from the last point (Stroke & Distance Penalty). E.g. If a Tee shot is lost, then the original stroke counts, there is a one-stroke penalty and the re-played stroke is, therefore, the third shot)

2. If you think a ball may be lost (not found within 3 minutes), please play a Provisional Ball – clearly saying so aloud. If the Provisional Ball becomes a ball in play because the original ball is not found, it will have the same status as above (Stroke & Distance Penalty)

3. **Dropping a Ball** : Whether a Free drop or a Penalty drop, it must be dropped from **Knee height.**
