GOVERNER'S CUP GOLF TOURNAMENT-2025

1. The 20th Governor's Cup Golf Tournament was conducted by RBGC under the supervision of the Executive Committee at Raj Bhawan Golf Club, Nainital from 30,31 May- 01 June 2025.

2. The main objectives of the tournament are as follows :-

A. To build awareness of the excellent golfing facilities at Raj Bhawan Golf Club, Nainital and enable its access to the golfers from all over the country and Students (Boys and Girls) in and around Nainital and Uttarakhand.

B. To further develop Uttarakhand as a Golf Tourism destination for domestic and international golfers under Khelo India Movement.

PARTICIPATION

3. Though 185 golfers had confirmed their participation. However later 177 golfers turned up for the tournament. Compared with the size of this par 66 course, this number and response of participants after the long break was particularly very good.

4. The golfers travelled from the states of Punjab, Haryana, Delhi, Uttar Pradesh, Jharkhand, Rajasthan, Chandigarh, Maharashtra and Uttarakhand.

8. The President RBGC & Hon'ble Governor has also expressed that due recognition be given to the Girl Child so as to bring awareness for the upliftment of Ladies and the Girl Child.

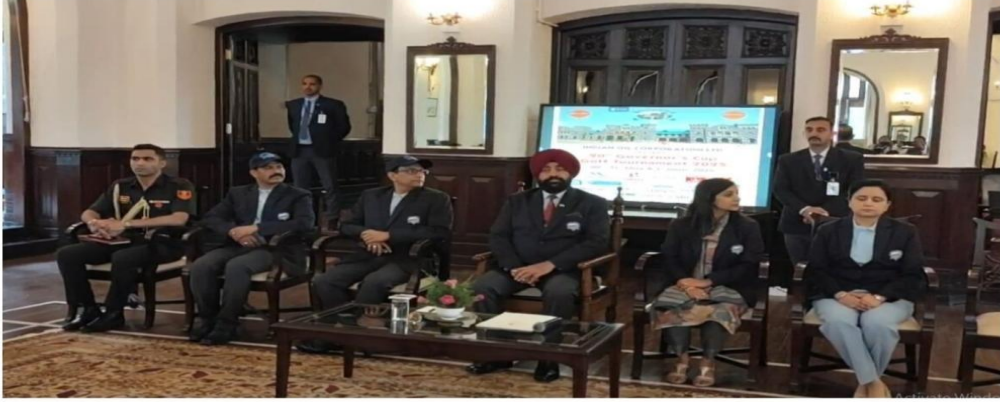
CURTAIN RAISER / PRESS MEET

9. The Press meet was held on 29 May 2025.

नैनीताल : उत्तराखण्ड के नैनीताल स्थित राजभवन गोल्फ कोर्स (RBGC) में आज 20वें गवर्नर्स कप गोल्फ प्रतियोगिता का औपचारिक कर्टेन रेजर आयोजित किया गया। इस मौके पर राज्यपाल लेफ्टिनेंट जनरल (से.नि.) गुरमीत सिंह ने मीडिया से बातचीत करते हुए बताया कि 30 मई से 1 जून 2025 तक चलने वाली इस प्रतियोगिता में देशभर के 177 खिलाड़ी भाग लेंगे।



राज्यपाल ने कहा कि इस वर्ष प्रतियोगिता को खास बनाने के लिए गोल्फ कोर्स के सभी 18 होल्स को उत्तराखण्ड की प्रमुख पर्वत श्रृंखलाओं और नदियों के नाम दिए गए हैं। यह अभिनव पहल न केवल खिलाड़ियों के लिए आकर्षण का केंद्र बनेगी, बल्कि राज्य की प्राकृतिक विरासत को भी प्रदर्शित करेगी।

: CONDUCT OF THE TOURNAMENT :

12. Due to ground constraints and keeping in mind the safety of participants, caddies, supervisory staff viz marshals, referee and others the tournament was extended over three days to accommodate all the participants.
13. The tournament was played over 09 holes Stroke play with modified handicap.
14. On the first day, half the number of participants played 09 holes Stroke Play and on the second day the remaining participants played the same 09 holes.
15. A cut was applied on the third day so that the best golfers play on the final day. A total of 44 players made the cut and these golfers played 18 holes based on Stroke play format.
16. There were separate categories for ladies, junior boys and girls below 17 years. Besides this there was a general category, veteran category and super veteran category for golfers.

ACCOMODATION

17. The summer in Nainital always coincides with the vacations and peak tourist season makes it difficult to get accommodation in local hotels. Raj Bhawan used their good office to arrange accommodation at various places. Besides this, golfers were issued within formation well in advance so that they could directly book accommodation as per their requirement.

MANAGEMENT

18. The Executive Committee of the Raj Bhawan Golf Club took it as a challenge to conduct and manage the tournament of this magnitude by its own staff. This being their personal venture, no stone was left unturned by them so as to make the event a rewarding success. In spite of all odds the tournament was conducted smoothly and acclaimed whole hearted appreciation by all golfers.
19. The press gave good reviews about the Tournament and especially for the students coaching and their tournament.
20. Officers of Raj Bhawan, Dehradun and volunteers of RBGC were a great help in assisting us to this extent.

GIVE-AWAYS

23. RBGC has been very generous in distributing the give-aways to all the participants. Each golfer was given a Bag containing T-Shirt, Golf Cap with RBGC Logo, Sleeve of golf balls (Taylor made RBZ), Towel set, Golf Jacket, Gents Wallet and Sling Bag.

First Days Play

24. After the Inaugural Ceremonial Tee-off conducted by the Hon'ble Governor of Uttarakhand and President, RBGC, Lt Gen Gurmit Singh at 0830 hrs, 66 golfers Tee'd - off for the first day play. The last four balls finished 18 holes by 1500 hrs.

Second Days Play

35. 111 Golfers including ladies and juniors teed-off for the second days play starting at 0630 hrs onwards. The second days play went off more smoothly after the initial dust had settled down. The Result of the first and second days play enabled the tournament committee to make the cut off for players to play on the final day. The draw of the players making the cut for final day was displayed at the venue of the Gala dinner, as planned, for all golfers and spouses.

Third Days Play

36. On the third day, 44 golfers including Ladies and Juniors making the cut were made to play 18 holes Stroke play. First Tee off was at 0700 hrs. It was an ideal day to play golf with a light blue sky mixed with some clouds and a mild breeze. All players finished 18 holes by 1300 hrs. Since enough time was available till the prize distribution ceremony to be held at 1700 hrs, the result could be compiled, checked and rechecked to avoid any controversy.
37. An IGU qualified Class A Referee was invited as part of the Tournament Committee to insure fair play and transparency in the tournament.

Prize Distribution Ceremony

38. The prize distribution ceremony took place at 1700 hrs in the Ball Room of Raj Bhawan, Nainital.
39. The ceremony commenced with on arrival of The Hon'ble Governor of Uttarakhand and President, RBGC, Lt Gen Gurmit Singh to give the trophies to winners and the runners up. It was followed by a welcome address by the Golf Captain who also gave the tournament report.
40. Results were then announced.
41. After the prize distribution the Hon'ble Governor of Uttarakhand and President, RBGC Lt Gen Gurmit Singh addressed the golf fraternity. Secretary to Governor and Senior Vice President, RBGC Mr. Ravinath Raman, IAS gave the relevance of Golf in the present world scenario wherein it is no longer an entertainment sport for the rich but a professional sport as well. Leadership qualities of golf were highlighted by him.
42. The ceremony concluded with a Vote of Thanks by the Secretary, RBGC and ADC (P) to Hon'ble Governor Mr. Amit Srivastava, IPS.
43. High tea was laid in the main dining hall of Raj Bhawan. It was attended by the participants along with their family members together with the invitees and members of media.

Safety First : There are several crossing sections of the golf course. Play carefully.

Core Principal : “Play the course as you find it. Play the ball as it lies”

Format of Play :

1. STROKE PLAY. Its GROSS play Tournament.
2. For Final day, handicap will be calculated by Tournament Committee.

Completion of Hole :

1. **Stroke Play :** All holes must be played and Ball to be holed, however after two over, ball will be picked up by the player and hole will be considered as double bogie– there is no “given. For example, if a player is playing Par 3 hole, after completing 5 strokes, player is required to pick up ball, similarly for Par 4 hole, player is required to pick up ball only after 6 clear strokes.
2. **On putting Green/Brown :** No Change of ball, Ball to be replaced by the person who has lifted the ball, For example, On Green/Brown if ball is marked, lifted and cleaned by the caddy, then the original ball will be replaced only by the Caddy or if ball is lifted by the player, then the Original ball will be replaced by the player only. Breach will invite 01 Penalty stroke. No Change of ball on the Green/brown.

Pace of Play:

- i) Ready Golf to be played: those in position and able to play will make the stroke.
- ii) Ball search time is a maximum of three minutes.
- iii) The maximum permitted time for 9 hole is 3 Hours.

Course Markings :

Fairways : Fairway edge is marked with white bricks. Hole no 3 has been divided into two parts, Left fairway will be considered as fairway of hole no 3 and Right fairway will be considered as wrong fairway for hole no 3. The ball in wrong fairway will invite one Penalty stroke and ball to be played from the same place.

Penalty Relief : Ball outside fairway marking :

1. Play as it is from rough.
2. Place the ball on the line with one penalty Stroke on fairway marking line (recommended). Not applicable if ball is lost/not found.
3. Course is having few nallahs and the nallahs on the fairway are entitled free drop. However Nallah outside fairway will have penalty relief of one stroke.

Penalty Areas : Red Penalty Area (Water body and this is also a 'No' Play Zone)

Common to HoleNo.-2, 7, 8 and back Hole No.- 11,16 and 17

Preferred Lie : There is one club length preferred lie (not nearer to the hole) within Fairway markers only. Before lifting the ball, first mark the spot then lift the ball, failing which will invite ONE stroke penalty. Player is the only person who can lift the ball and can replace the ball in General area for taking preferred lie.

Drop Zones (DZ) :

- i) Where provided, Drop Zones **must** be used if relief is taken (to aid the Pace of Play) – a Penalty of one stroke will apply
- ii) Drop Zones are marked on Hole 1, 4, 5, 7 and 8 and back nine (10, 13, 14, 16 and 18). DZ may be, in some situations, closer to the hole.

No Play Zones : Play is prohibited from these areas players are not permitted to enter or play, and will take mandatory penalty relief:-

1. Red penalty area (Water body on Hole no. 2, 7, 8 and Hole no 11, 16, 17)
2. Ditch on hole no 7 & 16.

Penalty for Breach of Rule. Two stroke penalty for each stroke taken by player.

Free Relief : Ball going inside fairway stone drains/ Mud drains:- take a free drop within 2 club lengths, no closer to the hole.

Browns have wall behind the brown. Ball touching the wall, player can shift the ball 6" ahead from the wall in the line of putt.

Tee-Off Timing and Late Comers:

- i) Players need to report on the tee at the designated times
- ii) Late comers will be accommodated (if possible) at the discretion of the Tournament Committee with the next flight with a vacant slot
- iii) Late for more than 15 minutes - DQ

Play Cannot be Completed : If or any reason, play cannot be completed, the number of holes to be played/to be counted will be decided by the Tournament Committee.

Format of Tournament. On 30 and 31 May, all the participants will play only 09 holes and on final that is 01June, will be played 18 holes

Useful Extracts from the Rules of Golf, 2025:

1. Maximum time to search for a ball is 3 minutes. If a ball is not found within 3 minutes, the ball is considered LOST and the **ONLY** option is to replay the stroke from the last point (Stroke & Distance Penalty). E.g. If a Tee shot is lost, then the original stroke counts, there is a one-stroke penalty, and the re-played stroke is, therefore, the third shot).
2. If you think a ball may be lost (not found within 3 minutes), please play a Provisional Ball – clearly saying so aloud. If the Provisional Ball becomes a ball in play because the original ball is not found, it will have the same status as above (Stroke & Distance Penalty)
3. Dropping a Ball : Whether a Free drop or a Penalty drop, it must be dropped from knee height.

4. After completion of every hole, Score to be filled before starting another hole, Not filling score in score card or Loss of score card, the player will be DQ. This is the responsibility of player to ensure marker has filled the score card. All cutting to be signed by Marker without fail, Martials/Referee/Tournament Committee members shall be checking the score card at random to avoid any wrong scoring. Wrong score, DQ.
5. All players are required to know the Local rules as given above, Not knowing the Local Rules is No excuse and player will be penalised for any breach of local rule.
6. Nospectators/Coach/ParentsareallowedonthecourseduringtheTournament.
7. All the applied Rules as per guidelines of R&A.
8. IMPORTANT- In case ofanyDoubt, please ask from Referee/Tournament committee.
9. Please Do not assume.
