RESOLUTION:

Government has decided that the surviving widows of the Hutatmas who have laid their lives for the emancipation of the Country and each of the Hutatmas' surviving parents i.e. Mother and Father should be granted a monthly pension of Rs.150/- (Rupees one hundred fifty) with effect from 9th September, 1980 and that these pensions should be continued to them at the same rate for their life time.


2. Government has also directed that the payment, on account of arrears of the amount of pension sanctioned in para 1 above to the widows of Hutatmas and each of the Hutatmas' parents should be paid to them on 9.8.1981.

3. Government has also decided that the present rate of pension of Rs.100/- p.m. granted to the Freedom Fighters under the State Government Scheme should be increased from Rs.100/- p.m. to Rs.150/- p.m. with effect from 1.8.1981. //

4. The expenditure mentioned in paras 1 and 3 above should be debited to the budget head "288-Social Security and Welfare-(e)-other Social Security and Welfare Programme-(c) Pension to the Freedom Fighters, their dependents etc-Demand No.13" and met from the Contingency Fund advance of Rs.9,88,000/- sanctioned under Government Memorandum, Finance Department No. CNF-1181/140/BUD-B dated 6.8.1981. Steps should be taken in due course to present the necessary supplementary Demand to the Legislature for recouping Contingency Fund advance and also to meet the additional expenditure on account of these proposals for the period till 28th February, 1982.


