

Grant of pension to Freedom Fighters,
their dependents, etc.

RESOLUTION:- In continuation of the orders issued in the Government Resolutions and Corrigendum mentioned in the Preamble Government is pleased to direct that-

- i) Freedom Fighters from the State of Maharashtra, who have suffered imprisonment for a minimum period of one month, inclusive of detention period, or who were externed or interned for a similar period and the widow/widowers/ of such Freedom Fighters should be held eligible for the State Pension of Rs.150/-p.m. The condition of 4 months of underground work in respect of the underground Freedom Fighters will, however, remain unchanged;
- ii) The condition regarding income limit should be removed in respect of both categories of Freedom Fighters, i.e. those who had suffered imprisonment and those who were underground workers and ;
- iii) all Freedom Fighters, who were or are in receipt of pension under the Government of India's scheme for grant of pension and widows of such Freedom Fighters should be held eligible to receive, in addition to the Government of India's pension, 25% of the amount of

pension admissible to Freedom Fighters under the State Scheme.

2. These orders take effect from 1st February 1982.
3. The expenditure on this account should be debited to the Budget Head "288-Social Security and welfare(e) Other Social Security and Welfare Programme-(C)-Pension to Freedom Fighters, their dependents, etc. Demand No.13" and met from the grant thereunder.
4. This Resolution issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its un-official reference No.450/EXP-4/82 dated the 12th February 1982.
