Government Resolution


Under Government Resolution No. POS-1083/FF Cell, dated 22/7/1986, orders have been issued to give pension to those Freedom Fighters who receive Pension from Maharashtra Government through Public Sector Banks. This Scheme was formulated as per Central Government Scheme. To solve the difficulties arising in the reconciliation of expenditure on payment of Pension through Banks as per this Scheme, some suggestions were received from the Reserve Bank of India. Taking into consideration these suggestions it has been decided that the Government Resolution dated 22/7/1986 should be amended as follows :-

- 1) As per para 4.6 of the Annexure A of original Government Resolution dated 22/7/1986, it is prescribed that advice of Pension payment is to be sent by the paying branch to its link branch on the 10th of each month. Now this date should be prescribed as "on the 5th of each month or before". In the Pension payment order details of Treasury Voucher/Tokenwise payment amount and date should also be included.
- 2) In para 4.7 of the Annexure A of original Government Resolution dated 22/7/1986, it is mentioned that on receipt of payment advices and three copies of the scrolls alongwith necessary supporting documents from the paying branches in the district, the link branch will send them to Reserve Bank of India/State Bank of India by 15th of each month. Now the said date should be prescribed as "on the 7th of each month or before".

- 3) At the end of para 5 of the Annexure A of original Government Resolution dated 22/7/1986, a new sentence should be added as " on the 10th of each month or before it should be sent to the Treasury Officer/Pay and Accounts Officer".
- 4) At the end of para 5 of Annexure A of original Government Resolution dated 22/7/1986, a new sentence should be added as " and Freedom Fighter Cell of the concern Collector's Office".

2. These directions will come in operation from 1st September 1994.
