Circular :-

The instructions regarding the period occupied in appearing an obligatory departmental examination to be treated as duty has been laid down in Bombay Civil Services Rule No.9(16) f. This concession is not allowed more than twice for each departmental examination. Since the number of chances permissible under the Rules regarding the Examination for promotion to the posts of Superintendents exceed two, the question whether the period occupied in appearing the departmental examination for promotion to the posts of Superintendents, when a candidate appears for more than two times, should be treated as duty or otherwise was under the consideration of Government. It has now been decided that actual physical appearance of the candidates at the first two examinations out of the examinations/chances taken by the candidate should be treated as duty and appearance at subsequent examinations should not be treated as duty.
