

Dependent family pension under the Swatantrata Sainik Samman Pension Scheme (SSSP), 1980 to the widows of the deceased freedom fighter pensioners.

Sir,

I am directed to invite your attention to this Ministry's letter No. 8/16/81-FF(P) dated 28th July 1982 addressed to all the Chief Secretaries of State Government's and Union Territory Administrations (endorsing a copy to all A.Gs) intimating the decision of the Government of India to continue the practice of treating widows of deceased freedom fighters as separate entities for granting them full amount of family pension admissible under the Swatantrata Sainik Samman Pension Scheme (SSSP). Now this matter has been reviewed and it has been decided/no discontinue it as this practice is not in consonance with the established laws and general principles of family pension as applicable in Government sector on the subject //

2. Therefore in supersession of all earlier orders the following procedure/position would be adopted in all future cases :-

i. That as provided in the Swatantrata Sainik Samman Pension Scheme (SSSP), 1980 not more than one eligible dependent can be granted family pension after the death of the freedom fighter who was in receipt of Samman Pension under the said Scheme.

ii. That the claimant of family pension should fulfill the twin conditions of falling into the eligible category of relationship i.e. widow, widower, unmarried daughter, mother or father and their dependence on the deceased freedom fighter. It has to be certified that such a dependent does not have any independent means of livelihood.

iii. That for the event of availability of more than one eligible dependent the sequence of eligibility, not more than one at a time, will be in the following order:-

1. widow/widower
2. unmarried daughter
3. mother and father

subject to the instruction issued under the Scheme from time to time.

iv. That in case the deceased freedom fighter had communicated to the Ministry the nomination of more than one legally wedded wives as dependents, the family pension admissible to one dependent widow would be shared by them.

equally. Such widows would not be treated as separate entities for grant of family pension under the aforesaid scheme.

3. The aforesaid decisions take effect from the date of issue.
4. You are, therefore, requested to issue instructions to all concerned to follow these instructions in pension payment orders under intimation to this Ministry.
