CONSTITUTION OF INDIA.

No. EXM. 1284/XVII.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Maharashtra is hereby pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Maharashtra Government Subordinate Mantralaya Service (Superintendents) Departmental Examination Rules, 1977, namely:—

1. (1) These rules may be called the Maharashtra Government Subordinate Mantralaya Service (Superintendents) Departmental Examination (Amendment) Rules, 1984.

(2) They shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st June 1977.

2. In rule 3 of the Maharashtra Government Subordinate Mantralaya Service (Superintendents) Departmental Examination Rules, 1977 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal rules"), the following *Explanation* shall be added at the end, namely:—

"*Explanation.*—In case of a Lower Division promotee, the period of 5 years continuous service in the Upper Division, shall be counted from the date of his continuous officiating in the post of Assistant and not from the date of his promotion or as Assistant in accordance with the provisions of the relevant recruitment rules."

3. In rule 7 of the principal rules, after the words "in any particular year" the following shall be inserted, namely:—

"after an Assistant becomes eligible to appear for the Examination."

4. In rule 15 of the principal rules, after the words "or more" the word "marks" shall be inserted.
