


- In February 2024, the Housing Department received one PG case, while the School Education & Sports Department also received one, resulting in a total of two cases received.
- A total of **2232 PG cases were brought** forward by various departments.
- Out of the total cases brought forward and received in the month, **85 PG cases were disposed of**.
- The Water Resources Department is the only department with a 100% disposal rate of received PG cases.
- These departments- Water Resources Department, Environment Department and Medical Education & Drugs Department are disposing of PG cases in less than 150 days.









#### Status of disposal of PG cases on Aaple Sarkar - CPGRAMS:



## An average number of days taken by departments to dispose of PG Cases:






Status of pendency of PG cases on Aaple Sarkar -

- As of February 2024, there are **2149 pending PG cases** across different departments.
- The Law & Judiciary Department, Marathi Language Department, Public Works Department, Revenue & Forest Department, and Tourism Department have a 100% pendency rate for received PG cases.
- The Revenue & Forest Department, Rural Development Department, Agriculture Department, Tourism Department, and General Administration Department (IT) have more than 50 pending PG cases.






### Pending PG cases as of February:
