

Status of Public Grievances on Aaple Sarkar - CPGRAMS


- In March 2024, a total of 173 PG cases were received across the different departments.
- Different departments in Mantralaya forwarded 2224 PG cases in March.
- Out of the total cases brought forward and received in the month, **111 PG cases were disposed of**.
- The Home Department (Transport) and Industries, Energy & Labour Department are the only 2 departments with a 100% disposal rate of received PG cases.
- The Home Department (Main), Industries, Energy & Labour Department, and Food, Civil Supply & Consumer Protection Department are disposing of PG cases in less than 150 days.








Status of disposal of PG cases on Aaple Sarkar - CPGRAMS:




An average number of days taken by departments to dispose of PG Cases:







Status of pendency of PG cases on Aaple Sarkar - CPGRAMS




- As of March 2024, there are **2286 pending PG cases** across different departments.
- The Agriculture Department, Environment
 Department, Finance Department, Revenue &
 Forest Department (forests), Tribal Development
 Department, Urban Development Department,
 Water Resources Department, and Tourism
 Department have a 100% pendency rate for received
 PG cases.
- The Revenue & Forest Department, Rural Development Department, Agriculture Department, and Tourism Department have **more than 100 pending PG cases**.






Pending PG cases as of March:
