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#### **Executive Summary**

This is the 14th edition of Mantralaya Monthly Reforms Report.

#### e-Office Analytics:

The November 2024 Report highlights trends in e-Office performance, where the Home Department created the most e-files (269), followed by Revenue & Forest (132) and Water Supply & Sanitation (127). Conversely, the Gazetteers Department and Revenue & Rehabilitation recorded no e-files.

Among *collector offices*, Ratnagiri & Satara led with 3018 & 2190 e-files respectively, while **Beed** recorded **none** & Sangli with 5 e-files.

Similarly, for *Zilla Parishad* Ratnagiri topped the list with 3,338 e-files followed by Sangli with 2051 e-Files, while Buldhana & Dharashiv were among the lowest with just 26 & 34 e-files.

#### **Grievance Portal Analytics:**

The Grievance Portal revealed high pendency rates in specific departments. Departments such as Home-Jails (98%), GAD-Freedom Fighter/Ex-Servicemen Welfare (97%), and Medical Education & Drugs (97%) recorded the highest pendency rates. In contrast, departments like Finance-Reforms, Marathi Language, and Information Technology demonstrated commendable performance with low pendency rates.

#### **Right to Information (RTI) Analytics:**

The RTI analytics Portal revealed high pendency rates in departments like **School Education** & Sports (92%) and Finance (86%) exhibiting significant pendency rates.

Among collector offices, Bhandara, Dhule, and Gadchiroli reported 100% pendency, indicating complete delays, while Chandrapur (7%), Jalna (18%), and Nandurbar (33%) performed better with lower pendency rates.

Similarly, *Zilla Parishad* offices in Akola, Beed, and Bhandara showed 100% pendency, whereas Dharashiv (31%) and Jalgaon (49%) demonstrated improved performance.

In *Home-Police* departments, at the *Commissioner level*, Nagpur recorded the highest pendency rate at 95%, while Mumbai reported the lowest at 46%. At the *Superintendent level*, Satara displayed 100% pendency, in contrast to Thane Rural, which reported 0%, indicating efficient handling.

Additionally, *municipal corporations* such as **Ahmednagar**, **Dhule**, and **Jalgaon** reported **100%** RTI pendency.

#### **Right to Services (RTS) Analytics:**

The RTS analysis focused on the Monthly Disposal Percentage and identified the Top Services availed by citizens.




## 2) Aaple Sarkar Pendency Percentage at Collector Office










## 4) Aaple Sarkar Pendency Percentage at Police Level


