Orthopedically Handicapped Students	45% marks	45% (In 1 st Language+ 2 nd Language + maximum marks obtained in 3 other subject)
Students with Hearing Impairment	Passed	Passed
Students with Mental Retardation	One student each from all Institution Sponsored by Department of MEE & LS, Govt. of West Bengal, nominated by the Head of the concerned Institution on the basis of last three year's assessment, or passed the Madhyamik or Higher Secondary equivalent examination.	

RATE

- @ Rs. 5000/- per students (OH/VI), Inmate of Social Welfare Home securing marks more than 45% and less than 60% in Madhyamik or Higher Secondary examination.
- @ Rs. 6000/- per students (OH/VI), Inmate of Social Welfare Home securing marks more than 60% in Madhyamik or Higher Secondary examination.
- @ Rs. 6000/- per students (HI), who has been successfully passed the Madhyamik or Higher Secondary Examination.
- @ Rs. 6000/- per students (MR), based on nomination of the school on the assessment of progress of the last three years or who has successfully passed the Madhyamik or Higher Secondary examination.
