

OFFICE MEMORANDUM.

Subject: Grant of Conveyance Allowance to blind and Orthopaedically handicapped Central Government employees.

The question of granting some assistance to blind employees and orthopaedically handicapped employees with disability of lower extremities, who generally require physical assistance for going to and coming from the place of their duty) has been under consideration of the Government. The President is now pleased to decide that such of the Central Government employees borne on regular establishments (including workcharged staffs), who are blind or are orthopaedically handicapped with disability of lower extremities, shall be granted a conveyance allowance of 10% of basic pay subject to a maximum of Ns.50/- per month, subject to the following conditions:-

- i) An orthopaedically handicapped employee will be eligible for conveyance allowance only if he had a minimum 40% permanent partial disability of both the upper and lower extremity deformities;
- ii) The conveyance allowance will be admissible to the orthopaedically handicapped employees on the recommendation of the Head of Crthopaedica Department of a Government Civil Hospital;
- iii) In the case of a blind employee, the allowaning will be admissible on the recommendation of the Head of Opthalmological Department of a Government Civil Hospital;
 - iv) The allowance will not be admissible during leave (except Casual Leave), joining time or suspension.

The President is also pleased to authorise all Heads of Departments to sanction conveyance allowance in terms of these orders. The Government servants concerned shall accordingly toply for the grant of conveyance allowance to the Heads of their bepartments. It shall be the responsibility of the Head of the appropriate medical authorities for obtaining their commendations for the grant of the conveyance allowance.
