ORDER

Shri Keshri Kumar Dubey, complainant filed a complainant dated 15.09.2014 before the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities under Section 59 of the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 intimating that he was selected for the post of Tax Assistant in Central Board of Excise & Customs (CB&EC) on the basis of his performance, skill test preference & documents/certificate submitted by him. After declaration of the result in February, 2013, he did not receive any nomination/appointment letter from the Staff Selection Commission (SSC). He further submitted that after his several personal visits and written request, a letter was received dated 02.09.2014 from SSC intimating that his candidature for the post of Tax Assistant in CBEC has been cancelled.

2. The matter was taken up with the Chairman. Central Board of Excise & Customs, New Delhi vide this Court's letter dated 31.10.2014 to submit their comments etc.

- 3. Department of Disability Affairs (now re-named as Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan) vide their letter dated 08.12.2014 also forwarded the representation of the complainant for taking appropriate action in the matter.
- 4. Upon considering the reply filed by Respondent No. 1 vide letter No. A-12034/71/2014-Ad.III B dated 30.12.2014, reply filed by Respondent No. 2 vide letters No. 10-1/2012-P&P-1 (Pt.II) dated 25.03.2015 & No. 10-1/2012-P&P-1 (Pt.II) dated 01.04.2015 and the rejoinder dated 15.08.2015 filed by the complainant, a hearing in the matter was scheduled for 18.04.2017.
- 5. During the hearing on 18.04.2017, the complainant and both the respondents were absent and nor any intimation was received about their inability to attend the hearing, despite the fact that the Notice of Hearing was sent on 29.03.2017 by Speed Post.
- 6. In light of Rule 42(4) of the Persons with Disabilities Rules, 1996, the complaint is dismissed in default

7. The case is accordingly disposed off.
