2. Submission of the Parties

2.1 The Court sought to know from the Respondents the present status with respect to the grant of promotion to the Complainant in accordance with the DoPT instructions on reservation in promotion to persons with disabilities. The representative of the Respondent submitted that the DPCs are being scheduled for effecting the reservation in promotion to persons with disabilities wef 30.06.2016 in terms of the DoPT OM dated 17.05.2022 read with the OM dated 28.12.2023. Sh. Jayant Kumar, the GM (HR) confirmed that the Complainant's case is part of the ongoing 2018 DPC Review, which involves a total of 146 individuals. He stated that the review process is currently in progress and is expected to be completed within two months. The 2018 Supreme Court ruling required a reset of all seniority lists, necessitating a re-evaluation of prior promotions. He assured the Court that it is expediting the process to address the matter promptly.

3. Observations and Recommendations:

- 3.1 The Court noted with concerns that the Respondent is making the same statement on the day of the hearing which they stated in their written statement dated 22.03.2024. The Court strongly criticized the delay of over 2 years in implementing the government policy on reservation in promotions.
- 3.2 The CCPD stated it may be constrained to resort to penal action if the Respondent establishment does not complete the process and submit an action taken report within one month from the date of receipt of this record of proceedings.
- 3.3 This is issued with the approval of the Chief Commissioner.
