RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

- 1. The Complainant was absent for the hearing. The Court, therefore, asked the Respondent to present the case. The Respondent stated that the complaint concerns the absence of reservation for Persons with Disabilities (PwDs) in the advertisement dated 16.10.2023 for Associate Professor positions at the Central University of Technology, Kokrajhar.
- 2. The Respondent acknowledged that PwD vacancies were not included in the advertisement, but informed the Court that the university is currently updating its roster to incorporate PwD reservation. All future advertisements will reflect this change.

- 3. The Court sought clarification from the Respondent on three points:
 - (a) The total number of advertisements issued since the implementation of the RPwD Act, 2016;
 - (b) The number of posts reserved for PwDs;
 - (c) The current number of PwD employees at the university.
- 4. The Respondent is directed to submit a written response within 15 days. The Court will schedule a further hearing upon receipt of this information.
- 5. This order is issued with the approval of the Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities.
