2. **RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS**:

- 2.1 At the outset, the learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Complainant submitted that the Complainant has been appointed as Deputy Director in the Ministry of Power on a loan basis. Although the Complainant's immediate grievance is resolved, the Counsel requests the Court's intervention for the following matters:
 - 1. Ensuring a reasonable tenure in the current assignment.
 - 2. Considering posting near the native place or allowing preference in posting as per DoPT instructions during future transfers.
 - 3. Clearing the pending medical leave
 - 4. Withdrawal of the Show Cause Notice issued to him for approaching the CCPD office.
- 2.2 The Court is of the view that the grievance raised in the Complaint dated 21.07.2024 has been redressed. The fresh prayers made during the second hearing can not be entertained at this stage. The first two prayers are speculative and premature. On the remaining two, the Complainant is advised to approach the GRO appointed by the Respondent in compliance with Section 23, read with Rule 10 of the RPwD Act and the Rules respectively, who shall dispose of the complaint within 14 days in accordance with the statutory provisions.
- 3. This case is disposed of accordingly.
