**Hearing:** A hybrid hearing in the matter was conducted by the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities on 28.08.2025. The following were present during the hearing:

## RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

- 1. Dr. Manju Yadav, with 60% locomotor disability (both legs), alleged non-selection for the post of Medical Officer (Community Health, Ayurvedic & Unani) under Advertisement No. 4/2021-2022 by the AYUSH Department, Uttar Pradesh, due to lack of reservation for Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD).
- 2. The Complainant provided her Disability Certificate, Aadhaar Card, and other public service commission advertisements but not the specific UPPSC Advertisement No. 4/2021-2022. The Respondent clarified the matter falls under the Uttar Pradesh State Government's jurisdiction, as the vacancy was advertised by UPPSC. The Court noted that, under Section 75(1)(b) and Section 80(b) of the RPwD Act, 2016, the State Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities (SCPD), Uttar Pradesh, has jurisdiction, not the CCPD.
- 3. The complaint is forwarded to the SCPD, Uttar Pradesh, and the Complainant is advised to pursue the matter there.
- 4. Accordingly, the instant matter is closed with the approval of the Chief Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities.
