RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

1. The Complainant submitted that despite having proper documentation, the Delhi Police, Anand Vihar PS, has not allowed him to construct a sewer line for his house at the behest of his neighbours. He also alleged harassment, humiliation, and intrusion by the local police. The Delhi Police on the other hand submits that this is basically a case of long standing dispute and quarrel of the Complainant with his neighbor, namely, Shri Awadhesh Mani Tripathi, r/o 12A, DDA apartments, Anand Vihar. In so far as the issue of sewer connection is concerned, the Delhi Police has no role in this and the same is within the purview of the MCD, who have denied permission.

2. It is not clear as to why the Complainant is not being permitted to construct a sewer connection at his home. This is also a prima facie case attracting the provisions of Section 92 of the RPwD Act, 2016, which makes intimidation, humiliation and insult of person with disabilities punishable by a jail term of upto 5 years.

3. Delhi Police and MCD to resolve the issue within 14 days. A copy of this Order is being forwarded to the Commissioner, MCD, alongwith the Delhi Police and the Complainant. The Complainant to follow up with the MCD, if he is not satisfied with the resolution provided by the Delhi Police and the MCD, the Complainant will be at liberty to approach this Court again. This case is closed accordingly.

5. This is issued with approval of Chief Commissioner for persons with Disabilities.
