
RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

1. The Complainant stated that he is being subjected to harassment and humiliation by the school authorities. He mentioned that a JSA named Mandeep insisted that he should first seek permission by saying "May I come in." The JSA further insulted him by addressing him with derogatory remarks such as "langada-loola." Since then, he has been continuously harassed by the school administration which is also attempting to implicate him in false and frivolous charges of misconduct.

2. The Respondent submitted that they have only limited information regarding the matter, noting that there are cross-allegations from the Complainant and the School Principal. They informed that an inquiry has already been initiated and the report is awaited. While accepting the maintainability of the case, they requested that the School Principal and the State Society which oversees the functioning of the EMRS, be impleaded as necessary parties.

3. The Court observed that the alleged conduct of the school administration is prima facie in violation of Sections 7 and 92 of the RPwD Act, 2016. Accordingly, it was directed that notices be issued to NESTS, the concerned Principal.

4. This is issued with the approval of the Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities.
