1. Gist of the Complaint:

1.1 Shri Ajay Kumar, a person with above benchmark Locomotor Disability, filed a complaint dated 03.07.2023 regarding the double transport allowance and other special concessions.

1.2 He stated that he has been working with the Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan since 29.06.2018, and was initially unaware of the benefits available to persons with disabilities, which delayed his application for a disability certificate.

1.3 That after learning about the provisions, he had approached the District Medical Board in Mahendargarh, Haryana, which issued him a temporary disability certificate (valid for five years from 21.10.2021). Following this, he applied for double transport allowance through the Principal of KV Pali, Rajasthan, on 20.12.2021 and again on 22.03.2023. However, his request was denied on the grounds that his disability certificate was not for a permanent disability. Despite repeated requests,

the allowance was not granted, leading him to seek the intervention of this Court.

2. Submission made by Respondent:

2.1 Despite the notice to file comments dated 26.07.2023 and the final reminder dated 06.09.2023, the Respondents had not filed the reply in the matter.

3. Hearing:

3.1 A hearing in hybrid mode was conducted on 16.04.2025. The following parties/representatives were present:

4. Observations and Recommendations:

4.1 The Court heard both parties. The Complainant stated that all benefits have been granted to him on 15th April 2025.

4.2 The Respondent informed the Court that the matter was put up before the Deputy Commissioner (Regional), Jaipur, and was resolved on the same day. Further, stating that the Complainant, Shri Ajay Kumar, Primary Teacher at Kendriya Vidyalaya, Pali, has been granted Transport Allowance at double the normal rate applicable to physically disabled employees, along with the applicable Dearness Allowance, subject to a minimum of ₹2250/- per month. The benefit has been sanctioned for the period from 18.12.2021 to 21.10.2026 (retrospectively) as per the submitted medical certificate.

4.3 The Court appreciates the efforts made by the Respondent. Upon considering the submissions of the parties, during the hearing and particularly the email dated 15.04.2025 of the Respondent; this Court concludes that no further intervention is warranted in the matter as the

grievance of the Complainant has been redressed by the Respondent.

5. The case is disposed of accordingly.
