RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

1. At the outset, the Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities asked the Complainant whether he cleared all the papers of his engineering course during (2017-2021) at BR Ambedkar NIT, Jalandhar, Punjab. The Complainant replied that he had cleared all the papers. However, when the Court asked him to produce the mark sheet for the final semester, he could not do so. He made certain comments about his lost opportunity to work with some big MNCs due to non-issue of the degree was not found relevant to the matter at hand.
2. The Court asked the Respondents about their stand on this matter. Though the Court has gone through their submitted reply but still the stand is to be cleared by the Respondents. Respondent No.1 submitted that the Complainant was a Mechanical Engineering student in the institute from 2017-2021 and the Complainant never filed a complaint in the EOP or PwD cell of the Institute regarding this issue.
3. Respondent No.1 submitted that the Complainant had two backlogs in subjects named Applied Thermodynamics-II and Fluid Mechanics-I of the 4th Semester. Hence, the graduation degree could not be issued. Respondent No. 1 further submitted that as per the regulation of the Institute, the maximum time allowed to complete the B. Tech. course is 8 years and this is the last year for the Complainant to complete his graduation.
4. The Court asked the Complainant to submit copies of mark sheets for all semesters within ten (10) days. If that happens, another hearing will be scheduled for **25.02.2025**.
5. This is issued with the approval of the Commissioner for Persons with Disabilities.
