RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

1. **Hearing:** A hearing in the hybrid mode in the matter was conducted on **25.11.2025** wherein the following were present during the hearing:

2. **Proceedings during the hearing:**

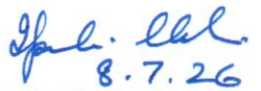
2.1 The Respondent No. 3, National Testing Agency (NTA), represented by Ms. Sarika Soam, submitted that the grievance relates to the NEET-PG examination, which is conducted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBE-MS) under the regulatory framework of the National Medical Commission (NMC), and not by the NTA. It was further submitted that the NTA conducts only certain undergraduate-level examinations, including NEET-UG and JEE. Accordingly, the NTA requested that its name be deleted from the array of parties

and that the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences be impleaded as the appropriate respondent.

2.2 The Respondent No. 2, National Medical Commission (NMC), represented by Ms. Priyanka Sati, Legal Assistant, was present during the hearing. The Court observed that the non-appearance of the Complainant had hindered effective adjudication of the matter. It further noted that the grievance pertains to the NEET-PG examination conducted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences under the aegis of the National Medical Commission and, therefore, the memo of parties required correction to reflect the appropriate examining authority.

2.3 Accordingly, the Court recommended that the National Testing Agency (NTA) be deleted from the array of parties and substituted by the National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBE-MS) as the proper Respondent. Fresh notice was ordered to be issued to the amended array of Respondents, including NBE-MS. The Complainant was also directed to remain present or ensure representation at the next hearing, failing which the matter shall be proceeded with *ex parte* on the basis of the material available on record.

2.4 Accordingly, the matter was adjourned for the next date of hearing i.e. **21.07.2026**.
