RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

1. Hearing: A hearing in the hybrid mode was conducted on 06.07.2026.

2. At the outset, it was noted that despite service of notice, the Complainant did not join the hearing.

3. The Respondent submitted that he had recently joined the office and was not aware of the facts of the case as the relevant records were not available with him. He requested a short adjournment to trace the records and furnish a detailed status report.

4. The Court observed that the complaint has remained pending for more than three years and expressed dissatisfaction over the Respondent's inability to apprise the Court of the present status of the matter. It was observed that administrative transfers or change of incumbency cannot be a ground for delay in disposal of complaints pending before this Court.

5. Accordingly, the Respondent is recommended to submit a comprehensive status report within two (02) days from the date of receipt of this Record of Proceedings.
6. The report shall clearly indicate, the present status of the complaint; the status of the missing person, if applicable; action taken by the Delhi Police till date; whether the matter has been settled, compromised, closed or remains under investigation; and copies of all relevant records/documents in support of the action taken.
7. In case of non-compliance with the above directions, this Court shall be constrained to proceed further in the matter on the basis of the material available on record and take such action as may be deemed appropriate in accordance with law.
8. Accordingly, the matter is adjourned and listed for hearing on 27.07.2026.
