RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS

1. Hearing (II): A hearing in hybrid mode was conducted on **21.07.2026**. The following parties/representatives were present during the hearing:

2. Proceedings of the hearing:

2.1 At the outset, despite repeated attempts by the Court to establish contact, the Complainant did not join the hearing and remained absent.

2.2 Respondent No. 4 (NBEMS) submitted that it had not received a copy of the complaint and requested that the same, along with the relevant particulars of the Complainant, be provided. The Respondent assured the Court that its response would be submitted within one or two working days thereafter.

2.3 Respondent No. 2 (NMC) submitted that it had already filed its written reply dated 26.09.2023. It was further submitted that the grievance raised by the Complainant related to the qualifying percentile prescribed for the year 2023. The Respondent stated that the qualifying percentile had subsequently been reduced to zero, thereby redressing the grievance.

2.4 Upon considering the submissions made by the parties, the Court recommended that a copy of the complaint along with the relevant particulars of the Complainant be furnished to Respondent No. 4 (NBEMS) to enable it to submit its response.

2.5 Considering the absence of the Complainant on two consecutive occasions coupled with the failure to furnish the requisite documents (UDID card/ Disability Certificate) despite sufficient opportunity, it is proposed that the matter may be listed for a third and final hearing i.e. on **04.08.2026**, making it clear that no further opportunity shall be granted. In the event of the Complainant's failure to appear or to furnish the requisite documents on the next date of hearing, the matter may be decided on the basis of the material available on record, including closure of the proceedings, if considered appropriate.
