1. Gist of the Complaint

1.1 The Complainant, Shri Rahul Agarwal, Manager (Scale-II), UCO Bank, submitted a grievance dated 06.07.2026 against UCO Bank challenging his transfer from Baneti Branch, Jaipur Zone, to another branch situated over 1,000 kilometres away. The Complainant submitted that he is the primary caregiver of his dependent brother, a person with 75% benchmark disability due to Thalassemia Major, who requires regular blood transfusions, continuous medical treatment, and emergency care at SMS Hospital, Jaipur. He further submitted that despite seeking exemption from transfer in light of the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 and the DoPT Office Memorandum dated 08.10.2018, the Respondent failed to consider his request.

2. Hearing

2.1. A preliminary hearing was conducted on 13.07.2026 in hybrid mode, wherein the following parties/representatives were present:

3. Record of Proceedings

3.1 During the proceedings, the Complainant reiterated that he is the principal source of logistical and financial support for his brother and also highlighted the advanced age and health concerns of his parents. The Respondent, represented by Shri Nagendra Jaiswal, Deputy General Manager (HR), UCO Bank, submitted that the Complainant had been serving in the Jaipur Zone since September 2018 and had completed his prescribed tenure at the present branch. It was further submitted that the impugned transfer was affected consequent upon the Complainant's promotion. The Respondent also informed the Court that the Complainant had already challenged the transfer order before the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court by filing S.B. Civil Writ Petition No. 10471 of 2026 on the same cause of action, wherein the Hon'ble High Court, vide interim order dated 07.07.2026, had stayed the operation of the transfer order and permitted the Complainant to continue at his existing place of posting. The Respondent accordingly prayed that the present complaint be disposed of, as the matter was already under judicial consideration

3.2 The Court observes that since the grievance raised in the present complaint, relating to the legality of the impugned transfer, is presently under active consideration before the Hon'ble High Court and interim relief has already been granted, the matter has become sub judice. In keeping with the settled principles of judicial propriety, this Commission refrains from entertaining parallel proceedings on an issue that is already seized of by a constitutional court. Accordingly, the Court determines no further intervention in the case. However, liberty is reserved to the Complainant to avail such remedies as may be available in law upon the final adjudication of the aforesaid writ petition.

4. Accordingly, the case is disposed of.
