### NOTIFICATION

No. CDR. 0615/CR-51/Spl-9.—Whereas the Government of Maharashtra is satisfied with analysis of call detail records and related documents which is valuable for control of forest and wildlife related offences. The State Government has decided to authorise certain forest officers to collect data information of call records, etc., as per the provision of the Information Technology (Procedure and Safeguards for Inception, Monitoring and Decryption of Information) Rules, 2009 as given below :—

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under rule 2 (d) and 4 of the said rules, the Government of Maharashtra hereby authorises the following officers of the Forest Department to collect data information of Call Details Records (CDR), Call Data Records (CDR), Live Tower Location (LTL) and Tower Dump Data (TDD) from the service providers while discharging their duties under the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972 and the Indian Forest Act, 1927.

As per the rule 11 of Information Technology (Procedure and Safeguards for Inception, Monitoring and Decryption of Information) Rule, 2009. The directions for interception or monitoring or decryption shall remain inforce, unless revoked earlier, for a period not exceeding sixty days from the date of this order, and may be renewed from time to time for such period not exceeding the total period of one hundred and eighty days.
