GSR.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of Ministry of Water Resources, the Farakka Barrage Project , Assistant (Group B), Recruitment Rules, 2013, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Assistant in the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Farakka Barrage Project, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.** – (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Farakka Barrage Project, Assistant (Group B), Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
2. **Application.** - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix.** - The number of posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** – The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
5. **Disqualification.** – No person, -
 - (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.** – Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving.** – Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedules Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

GSR.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of Ministry of Water Resources, the Farakka Barrage Project , Group C posts, Recruitment Rules, 2010, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk in the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Farakka Barrage Project, namely:-

1. **Short Title and Commencement:** - (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Farakka Barrage Project, Upper Division Clerk and Lower Division Clerk (Group C), Recruitment Rules, 2024.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. **Application:** - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in the column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix.** - The number of posts, their classification and Level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
4. **Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc.** - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating thereto shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.
5. **Disqualification.** - No person, -
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.
6. **Power to relax.** - Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provision of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Schedules Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
