G.S.R.....(E).- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (e) of sub-section (2) of section 28 read with sub-section (2) of section 8 of the Brahmaputra Board Act, 1980 (46 of 1980) and in supersession of the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Brahmaputra Board (Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Financial Adviser) Group 'A' Posts Recruitment Rules, 2019, in so far as it relates to the post of Financial Adviser, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Financial Adviser in the Brahmaputra Board, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Brahmaputra Board, Financial Adviser (Group 'A' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and level in pay matrix.- The number of the said posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

- a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note.- Where juniors who have completed their qualifying or eligibility service are being considered for promotion, their seniors would also be considered provided they are not short of the requisite qualifying or eligibility service by more than half of such qualifying or eligibility service or two years, whichever is less and have successfully completed probation period for promotion to the next higher grade along with their juniors who have completed such qualifying or eligibility service.

Deputation (including short-term contract):

Officers in the Central Government or State Governments or Union territory Administration:

(a)(i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department;

or

(ii) holding a post in level-13A in the pay matrix (Rs. 131100-216600) or equivalent with two years regular service, in the grade; or

(iii) holding the post in level-13 in the pay matrix (Rs. 123100-215900) or equivalent with three years regular service, in the grade;

exceeding fifty-eight years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
