Notification

New Delhi, the January, 2025

G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (b) of sub-section (2) of section 28 of the Brahmaputra Board Act, 1980 (46 of 1980) and in supersession of the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Brahmaputra Board (Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Financial Adviser) Group 'A' Posts Recruitment Regulations, 2019, in so far as it relates to the post of Vice-Chairman, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Vice-Chairman in the Brahmaputra Board, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Brahmaputra Board, Vice-Chairman (Group 'A' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2025.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.- The number of the said post, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

- a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward

Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Desirable:

Working experience in the field of Water Resources Management.

B. All India Service officers:

(i) holding an analogous post in the Central Government or State Government on regular basis and having working experience in the field of Water Resources Management; or
(ii) officers in level-13A (Rs.1,31,100-2,16,600/-) or level-13 (Rs. 1,18,500-2,14,100/-) in pay matrix or equivalent with two or three years regular service respectively and having working experience in the field of Water Resources Management.

Note1.- The period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation (including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or department of the Central Government or State Governments shall not exceed five years.

Note 2.- The maximum age-limit for appointment by deputation or short term contract appointment shall be not exceeding fifty-eight years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.
