Notification

New Delhi, the January, 2025

G.S.R.....- In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (c) of sub-section (2) of section 29 of the Brahmaputra Board Act, 1980 (46 of 1980) and in supersession of the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Brahmaputra Board [Chief Engineer (Level-I), Chief Engineer (Level-II) and Secretary] Group 'A' Posts Recruitment Regulations, 2020, in so far as it relates to the post of Chief Engineer (Level-II), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Chief Engineer (Level-II) in the Brahmaputra Board, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Water Resources, River Development and Ganga Rejuvenation, Brahmaputra Board, Chief Engineer (Level-II) (Group 'A' Post) Recruitment Rules, 2025.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification and level in the pay matrix.- The number of the said post, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications, etc. - The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification.- No person,-

- a. who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- b. who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.- Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward

Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories or persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Deputation (including short-term contract).

Officers of the Central Government or State Government or Union territory administrations or state electricity boards or public sector undertakings or statutory organisations or autonomous bodies or universities or recognised research institutions:

(A) (i) holding analogous post on regular basis in the parent cadre or department; or

(ii) holding the post in level-13 (Rs.1,23,100-2,15,900/-) in pay matrix with two years regular service in the grade; or

(iii) holding the post in level-12 (Rs.78,800-2,09,200/-) in pay matrix with six years regular service in the grade; and

(B) possessing Degree in Civil Engineering from a recognised University.

Desirable:

Working experience in the field of Water Resources Management.

Note 1.- The departmental officers in the feeder grade who are in direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation (including short-term contract) basis. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.

<p>Note 2.-The period of deputation (including short-term contract) including period of deputation (including short-term contract) in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation or Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed five years.</p> <p>Note 3.- The maximum age for appointment by deputation (including short-term contract) shall be not exceeding fifty-six years on the closing date of receipt of applications.</p>
