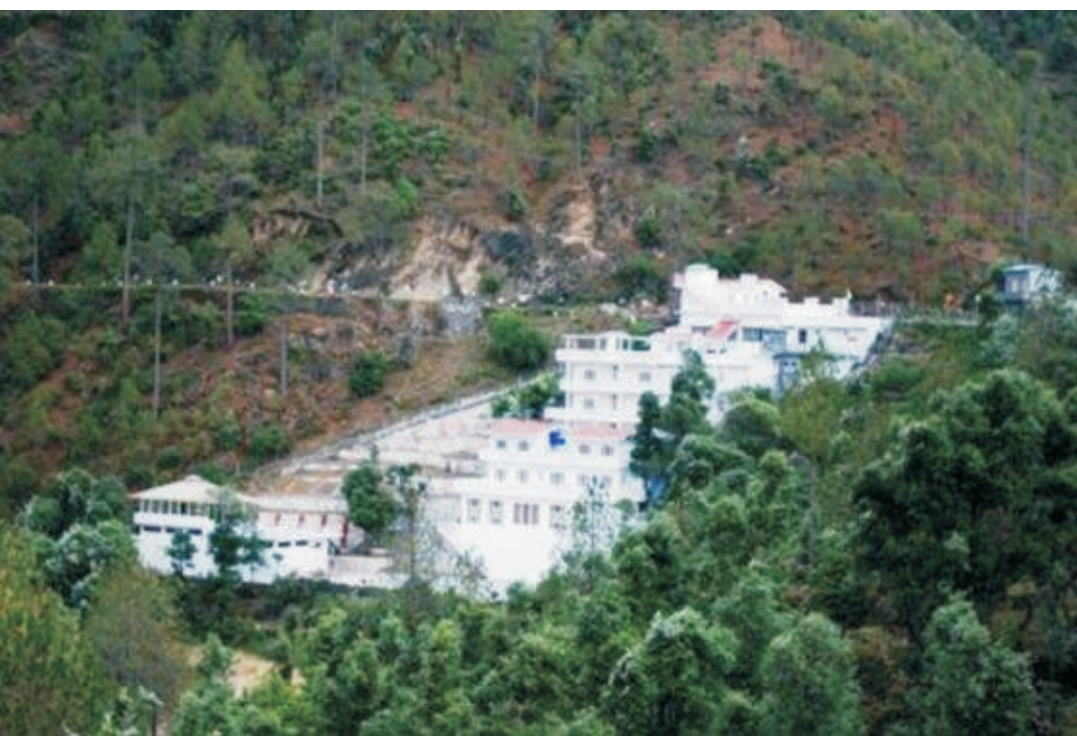


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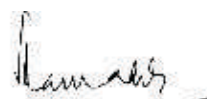
FOREWORD

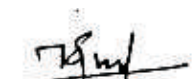

I hope that this publication will be very useful to all those who require the facts and figures for administrative and development planning and research.

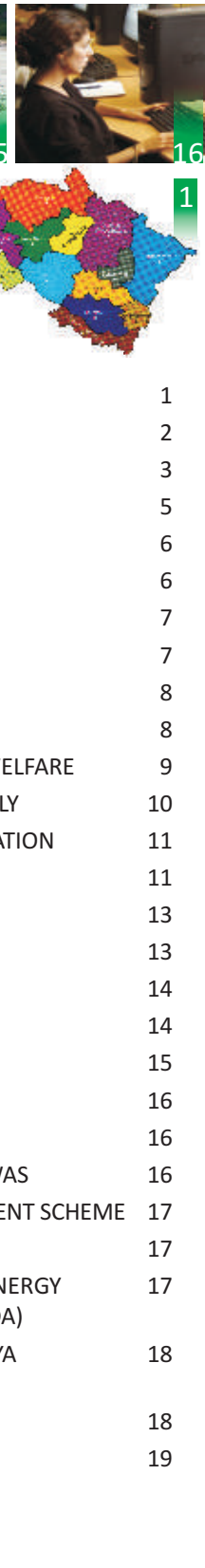
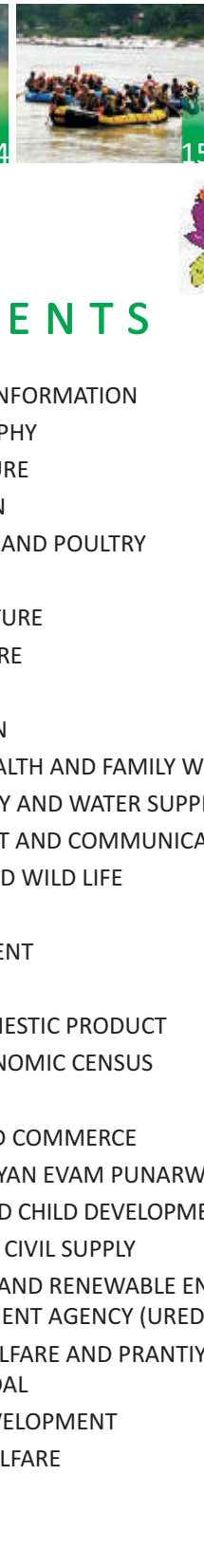

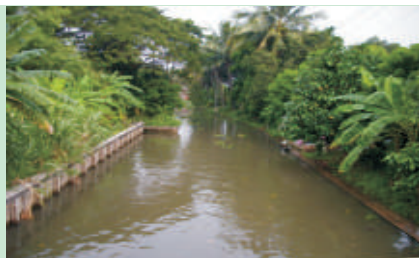
