

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I: About Estimation of State Domestic Product

(A) The SDP or State Income

The estimates of State Domestic Product (SDP), generally known as State Income, are considered as the most important macro-economic aggregates to measure the economic development of the state. The SDP of a State is defined as the aggregate money value of all goods and services produced within the geographical boundary of the state, counted without duplication with reference to a specific time period, usually a year. As SDP reflects the production capacity of any State, it simultaneously reflects outcomes of investments made, opportunities available and the likely impact of forthcoming economic policies. Thus, in the context of planned development of the economy of a state, the estimates of state domestic product and its derivative, per capita income plays a vital role since these estimates help government in formulating the policies and programmes as per critical economic analysis.

The broader utilities of the GSDP estimates are as follows:

1. To know the growth of the economy
2. To workout per capita income
3. For allocation of funds
4. To study structural changes in economy
5. For fixing the plan targets
6. To study the inter-state comparison

(B) Sectors of Economy

In order to estimate the SDP and State Income, the whole economy of a State is divided into 3 major sectors comprised of 13 sub-sectors as follows:

1-Primary Sector

- (i) Agriculture (including horticulture) & Livestock
- (ii) Forestry and Logging
- (iii) Fishing
- (iv) Mining and Quarrying

2-Secondary Sector

- (v) Manufacturing
 - (a) Registered

- (b) Un-Registered
- (vi) Construction
- (vii) Electricity, Gas and Water Supply

3-Tertiary Sector

- (viii) Transport, Storage and Communication
 - (a) Railway
 - (b) Transport by other means
 - (c) Storage
 - (d) Communication
- (ix) Trade, Hotel and Restaurants
- (x) Banking and Insurance
- (xi) Real Estate, Ownership of Dwelling, Business and Legal Services
- (xii) Public Administration
- (xiii) Other Services

(C) The Estimation Approaches

The estimates of SDP from the above sectors are prepared individually by adopting one or more of the following three approaches;

(C₁) Production Approach

This approach is applicable when an analyst has fair idea about outputs and inputs of a sector. Moreover, when the data on outputs and inputs is easily available. In this method the sum of economic values of all goods & services produced within the state boundary during the year is appropriately adjusted for the inputs consumed in the process of production i.e., production is calculated as the algebraic sum of outputs (+) and inputs(-). This approach is suitable for calculating SDP from Agriculture, Livestock, Forestry, Fishing, Mining & Quarrying and Manufacturing sectors.

(C₂) Income Approach

This approach is suitable when it is difficult to straight away calculate the Gross Value of Output (GVO), but one can reach/ calculate the Gross Value Added (GVA). The value addition is estimated taking into consideration the income accrued to the four factors of production namely Land, Labour, Capital and Entrepreneurship in the form of Rent, Salary and Wages, Interest and Profit. This approach is utilized in estimating domestic product from the sectors of Electricity, Gas and Water Supply, Transport, Storage and Communication, Trade, Hotel and Restaurant, Banking and Insurance, Real Estate, Business Services, Public Administration and Other Services.

(C₃) Expenditure Approach

This method is used when there is fair idea about the disposal of the product i.e., the quantity ultimately consumed (Consumption and Expenditure), the part of it is saved for future consumption (saving) and/ or for further production of goods and services. This method is based on measurement of income at the stage of disposal. All that is produced is either ultimately consumed or part of it is saved for future consumption or further production of goods and services. Thus, the money value of consumption and expenditure plus saving gives the income. This approach is used primarily in estimating income from construction sector.

The sector wise approaches mentioned above are not the ultimate and only possibilities. These may vary depending upon the data availability. One must note that GSDP can be prepared following either of three approaches and result should not vary. However, in practice it is not possible to use all these three approaches separately. Thus, a mix of approaches is normally used in SDP estimation.

(D) Current and Constant Price Estimates

An analyst may be interested to analyze the State Income or SDP estimates in two way:

- The actual increase in value terms i.e., the estimates of current output at current prices
- The increase in output i.e., the estimates of current output at constant prices (base year price)

Whereas, the first estimate helps in analyzing the overall impact of increase in price and increase in the quantity, the second estimate is used to analyze the increase in quantity terms, when the price effects are eliminated.

Following the above approaches two types of estimates of SDP and State Income are prepared – estimates at current and constant prices.

(E) Estimating the GSDP/ NSDP & PCI

Routinely, the GSDP/ NSDP estimation procedure is performed in five steps:

- Step 1: Calculation of GVA
- Step 2: Calculation of FISIM
- Step 3: Calculation of GSDP; Adjusting GVA for FISIM
- Step 4: Calculation of CFC
- Step 5: Calculation of NSDP; Adjusting GSDP for CFC
- Step 6: Calculation of PCI

It, therefore, seems necessary to understand the meaning of the terms that are used above, such as, GVA, FISIM, GSDP, CFC, NSDP & PCI.

(E₁) GVA

GVA of any sector is achieved as the net of outputs and inputs following approaches mentioned above. Mathematically,

$$\text{GVA} = \text{Value of Outputs} - \text{Value of Input- - - - - } (1)$$

(E₂) Financial Intermediation Services Indirectly Measured (FISIM)

There are various sectors in which banking and financial activities are involved but these are difficult to be considered while calculating GVA for those sectors of economy, such as agriculture, forestry, fishing, mining & quarrying, manufacturing, construction, electricity and gas, transport by other means, storage, trade, hotels and restaurants, business services and other services. Since banking and financing are supra-regional activities, it is difficult to calculate their impact (in terms of FISIM) on economy of any state. Thus, these estimates (of FISIM) are calculated at the CSO and supplied to different states. FISIM supplied to the states

are further distributed to different user industries within the state in proportion to the respective sectoral GSDP.

FISIM is defined as “an imputed income equivalent to interest and dividend receipt of banking and financial enterprises net of interest paid to depositors”.

(E₃) Gross State Domestic Product (GSDP)

The gross value added is worked out first by one or more of the approaches as indicated above and than an intermediate input (FISIM) is deducted to get GSDP.

Mathematically,

The GSDP of any sector is calculated as

$$\text{GSDP}_{(\text{unadjusted})} = \sum \text{GVA}; \text{ sum over sectors} \dots \dots \dots \quad (2)$$

$$\text{GSDP}_{(\text{Adjusted})} = \sum (\text{GVA} - \text{FISIM}); \text{ sum over sectors} \dots \dots \dots \quad (3)$$

(E₄) Consumption of Fixed Capital (CFC)

The fixed assets, such as land, building, plant & machinery etc. are used in the production process, and hence play a vital role in building up the GSDP. However, two things are possible either the fixed capital would depreciate or it could become obsolete. Thus, it is necessary to adjust the GSDP for the ‘Consumption of Fixed Capital (CFC)’ to reach to the estimates of NSDP.

CFC is defined as current replacement cost of the fixed assets used up (consumed) during a financial year as a result of normal wear and tear, and foreseen obsolescence.

CFC is specifically defined as the part of the gross product required to replace the fixed capital used in the production process. The industry-wise estimates of CFC are provided by CSO.

(E₅) Net State Domestic Product (NSDP)

The estimates of NSDP are arrived by deducting the estimates of Consumption of Fixed Capital (CFC) of concerned sector from the estimates of GSDP of that sector, and than aggregated to get the NSDP. Mathematically,

$$\text{NSDP} = \sum (\text{GSDP} - \text{CFC}); \text{ sum over sectors} \dots \dots \dots \quad (4)$$

(E₆) Per Capita Income (PCI)

The estimates of aggregated NSDP (at current and constant prices) so arrived at is divided by mid-year (financial) population to get Per Capita Income (PCI) i.e.,

$$\text{PCI} = \text{NSDP} / \text{Mid-year Population} - - - - - (5)$$

Note that it can be calculated using GSDP figures as well.

(F) Supra-Regional Sector

The activities of Railways, Communication, Banking & Insurance and Public Administration (Central Government) are not confined to one state. It is difficult at state-level to prepare estimates pertaining to the activities of these sectors within the state. The CSO therefore prepares the estimates at national level by allocating them to various states on the basis of appropriate physical indicators, e.g. length of railway track, number of telephone/mobile connections, number of bank branches, strength of central govt. staff etc.

(G) Three Principal Figures

Most of the users of SDP or State Income get puzzled with set of estimates floated before them, and find it difficult to select the appropriate one. It is for their ease to concentrate on following three estimates:

- (a) GSDP at current prices
- (b) Growth of GSDP at constant prices (Perceived as Growth Rate)
- (c) Per Capita NSDP at current prices (Perceived as Per Capita Income)

II: Brief Analysis of State Income Aggregates

(A) The GSDP & NSDP Estimates

The estimates of GSDP/NSDP and Per Capita GSDP/NSDP at Current and Constant (2004-05) Prices for the year 2004-05 to 2013-14 are given in Table – A below:

It can be observed from the above table that the estimates of GSDP, NSDP, and Per Capita NSDP at Current Prices, which are respectively ` 24786 Crores, ` 22288 Crores and ` 24726 during 2004-05 have gone up to ` 132969 Crores, ` 115868 Crores and ` 112428 in 2013-14. It means that these estimates have gone up by approximately, 536%, 520% and 455% respectively. Whereas at constant prices these estimates are ` 72984 crores, ` 62976 crores and ` 61106 respectively in 2013-14. Thus, it is clear that even at constant prices the GSDP, NSDP and Per Capita NSDP have gone up by 294%, 283% and 247%.

(B) Economic Growth of the State at Constant (2004-05) Prices

Although the above mentioned percentage increases reflect an overall growth of state's economy, it appears necessary to analyse the year-wise performance of state on various macro aggregates during the period 2004-05 to 2013-14. The year-wise economic growth in GSDP, NSDP and Per Capita Income (NSDP) at Constant (2004-05) Prices from 2004-05 to 2013-14 in percentage terms is presented in Table – B below:

It is clear from the above table that the state's economy achieved the highest growth rate in the year 2007-08 & 2009-10. It is mainly due to rapid performance observed in the sectors of manufacturing (registered), trade, hotel and restaurant and public administration during these years.

(C) Structural Change in The Economy

There are structural changes observed in the economy of the state, and this Table-C has been prepared to analyse the same.

From the above Table, it can be observed that considerable changes have taken place in the sectoral composition of the GSDP during the period 2004-05 to 2013-14. The tertiary sector has emerged as the major contributor through-out the period. The percent share of primary sector has declined from 23.48% to 13.73% (at current prices) and 10.26% (at constant prices). However percentage share of secondary and tertiary sectors have increased from 27.02% to 36.07% and 49.50% to 50.20% respectively during the reference period. It indicates contraction in the share of primary sector and expansion of secondary sector. The tertiary sector in the state has contributed almost stagnantly during the reference period; its contribution being nearly 50%.

III: GSDP/GDP & PCI of Uttarakhand and All-India

(A) The GSDP/GDP

The GSDP of Uttarakhand at constant prices is estimated as Rs. 72984 crores in 2013-14^A as against Rs. 24786 in 2004-05. Percentage share of GSDP of state to All-India GDP has increased from 0.83 in 2004-05 to 1.27 in 2013-14^A. Growth Rate of GSDP at constant prices of the state is observed as 9.9 percent, whereas national Growth Rate is 4.9 percent for the same year. Year-wise GSDP and Growth Rate of Uttarakhand and All-India can be observed in the Table-D below.

Further, it can be observed that average annual growth rate of GSDP at constant prices, which is 12.8% during the period 2004-05 to 2013-14 in Uttarakhand, is higher than the corresponding figure of 7.6% for the nation.

(B) The PCI

The Per Capita Income figure gives an idea of the economic development of the people living in the state. The Per Capita Income of Uttarakhand at current prices is estimated at Rs.12428 in 2013-14^A [Ref. Table-E].

Figure-1: Gross State Domestic Product of Uttarakhand




Figure-2: Net State Domestic Product of Uttarakhand




Figure-3: Per Capita Income of Uttarakhand




Figure-4: GSDP & Sectorwise Growth Rates at Constant (2004-05) Prices




Figure-5: Percentage Sectoral Share in GSDP at Current Prices




Figure-6: Percentage Sectoral Share in GSDP at Constant Prices




Figure-7: Percentage Share of Sectors of the Economy in GSDP during Base Year 2004-05




Figure-8: Percentage Share of Sectors of the Economy in GSDP at Current Prices during 2012-13



Advance Estimates of State Income of Uttarakhand (Year 2013-14)

State Income Estimate is **aggregate money value of goods and services** produced within the geographical boundary of an economic-region (Nation, State, District etc.), counted without duplication, during a specific period of time usually a year.

These are initially estimated for a Base Year (with respect to which growth/ development is reflected) and subsequently for forthcoming/ following years. Basically four estimates are prepared:

- (1) Gross State Domestic Product at Base-Year - GSDP at Constant Prices
- (2) Gross State Domestic Product at any Following-Year Prices - GSDP at Current Prices
- (3) Net State Domestic Product at Base-Year - NSDP at Constant Prices
- (4) Net State Domestic Product at any Following-Year Prices - NSDP at Current Prices

However, two more estimates/ indicators, as mentioned below, are also obtained:

- (5) Per Capita NSDP at Current Prices - Per Capita Income of the State
- (6) Percentage Change in GSDP (Calculated at Constant Prices i.e. Base-year Prices) of Current Year with respect to the Previous Year (This reflects the growth in actual production i.e. eliminating the effect of prices) - Growth Rate of the State

Uttarakhand can't attain first Position in above (1) – (4) estimates as number of states are bigger in size, established long back and they are already leading in various production activities. However, due to having lesser population and also having chances to grow considerably in any particular sector, it is very likely for a smaller or newly incepted state performing better on (5) and (6) above.

Directorate of Economics & Statistics (DES), Department of Planning is entrusted for preparing above estimates of the state, Advance estimates for the year are being released as enclosed. These estimates have been prepared primarily on the basis of data supplied by the Department of Agriculture and the Directorate of Budget (Department of Finance). Salient Features of the estimates are as follows:

1. Estimates based on Base Year (2004-05) Prices

The advance estimates based on base year (2004-05) prices (Constant Prices) for the year 2013-14 is estimated as INR **72984** Crores and for the year 2012-13 (Quick Estimates) it is INR **66356** Crores. Economic Growth Rates of the state for the year 2013-14 (Advance Estimates) and 2012-13 (Quick Estimates) have been estimated as **9.99%** and **9.01%** respectively.

According to the data released on 07 February, 2014 by the centre All India Economic Growth Rate for the year 2013-14 has been estimated as 4.9%, which is 4.5% for the year 2012-13 (Quick Estimates).

Growth rates of 'agriculture', 'industry' and 'services' are expected to be 3.96 %, 12.69 % and 9.22 % percent in the year 2013-14 for the state.

2. Estimates at Current Prices

Advance estimates of Gross State Domestic Product at Current Prices for the year 2013-14 is ₹ 132969 Crores, for 2012-13 (Quick Estimates) it is ₹ 113958 Crores. Estimates of Net State Domestic Product at Current Prices for the year 2013-14 (Advance Estimates) is estimated as ₹ 115868 Crores, 2012-13 (Quick Estimates) as ₹ 99157 Crores.

3. Per Capita Income





आर्थिक विकास दर और प्रतिव्यक्ति आय के मामले में उत्तराखण्ड राष्ट्रीय औसत की सीमा को लांघ जाएगा। योजना के अर्थ एवं संख्या निदेशालय के अनुमान के हिसाब से 2013-14 में राज्य की प्रतिव्यक्ति आय एक लाख के आंकड़े का पार कर जाएगी। इतना ही नहीं राज्य की आर्थिक विकास दर में इजाफा होने के आसार हैं। अनुमान के मुताबिक उत्तराखण्ड की आर्थिक विकास दर 9.9 फीसदी होने की संभावना है।

योजना विभाग के अर्थ एवं संख्या निदेशालय ने शनिवार को ये आंकड़े जारी किये। निदेशक वाईएस पांगती के मुताबिक विभाग ने 2013-14 के लिये राज्य की आय के अग्रिम अनुमान तैयार किये हैं। ये

अनुमान आधार वर्ष के वास्तविक आंकड़ों और संदर्भित वर्ष के आंकड़ों के तुलनात्मक विश्लेषण से तैयार होते हैं। राज्य के कृषि निदेशालय और वित्त विभाग के बजट आंकड़ों के तुलनात्मक अध्ययन के हिसाब से नये अनुमान तैयार किए गए हैं। पांगती के मुताबिक आधार वर्ष 2004-05 के मूल्यों (स्थायी भावों) पर राज्य घरेलू उत्पाद के अग्रिम अनुमान वर्ष 2013-14 में 72984 करोड़ रुपये है। उन्होंने बताया कि

वर्ष 2013-14 में राज्य की आर्थिक विकास दर 9.91 प्रतिशत रहने की संभावना है। वर्ष 2012-13 में (त्वरित अनुमान) में यह 9.01 प्रतिशत थी। आर्थिक विकास दर का यह आंकड़ा राष्ट्रीय औसत से कहीं ऊपर है। केंद्र सरकार ने सात फरवरी को जारी आंकड़ों में 2013-14 के लिए देश की आर्थिक विकास दर 4.9 प्रतिशत का अनुमान लगाया है, जबकि 2012-13 में उसका 4.5 प्रतिशत पुनरीक्षित अनुमान था। यहीं नहीं जारी आंकड़ों के हिसाब से 2013-14 में राज्य की प्रतिव्यक्ति आय 112428 रुपये तक पहुंचने की संभावना है। 2012-13 में त्वरित अनुमान के हिसाब से इसका 97528 रुपये होने का अनुमान लगाया गया था।
