1. KSWIFT (Ease of Doing Business)

Kerala - Single Window Interface for Fast and Transparent Clearance (K-SWIFT) for doing ease of doing business using ICT tools by integrating all the line departments using open API to bring under common platform.

It is an unified integrated platform for entrepreneurs to apply for all requisite clearances to start industry without any procedural delays in getting statutory clearances from various authorities concerned throughout the life cycle of projects.

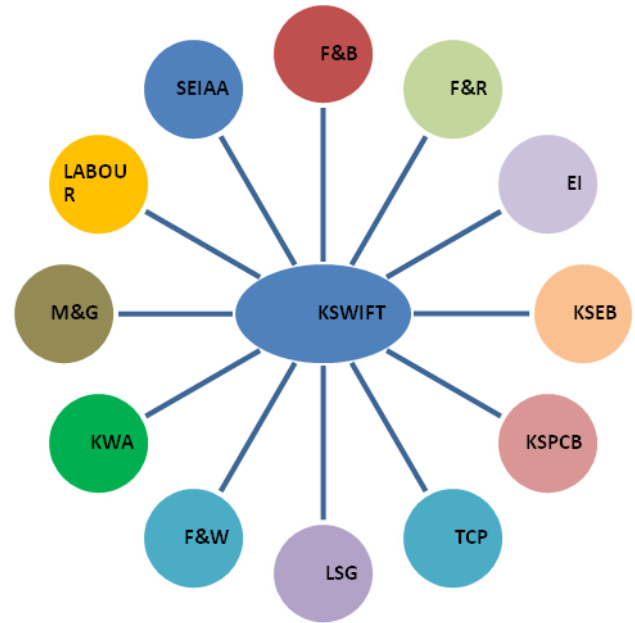

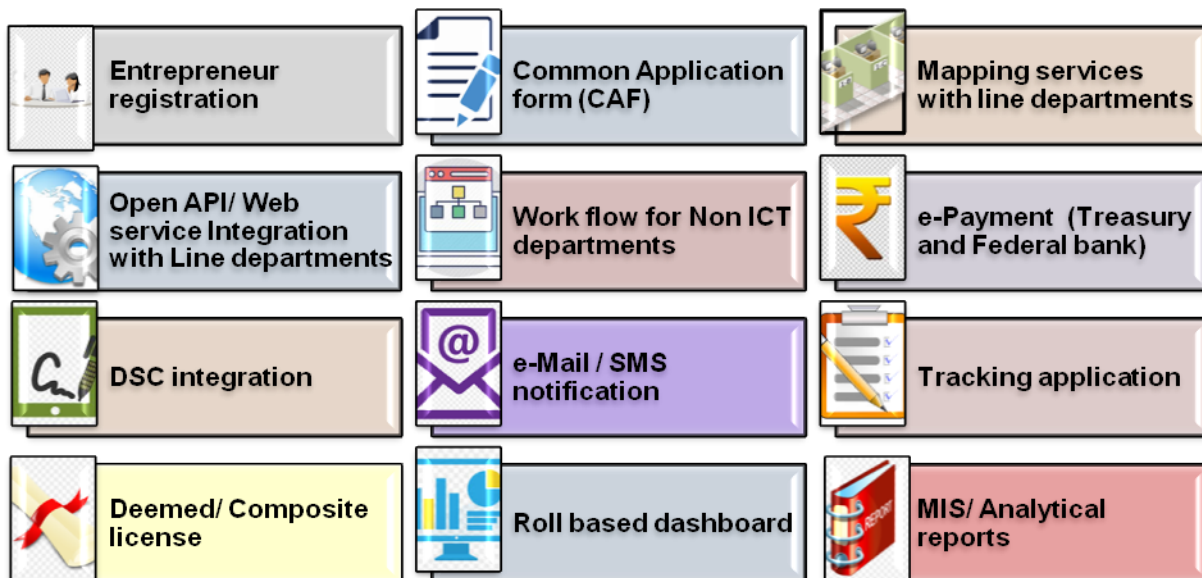

2. End to End Computerization of Public Distribution System

End to End computerization of Public Distribution System has radically transformed the rationing system in Kerala into a more efficient and transparent one in a short span. The State has implemented foolproof arrangements for the identification of the poor for delivery of food grains and for its distribution in a transparent and accountable manner at FPS level and enabled to avoid pilferage and corruption of ration commodities.

End-to-End Computerization comprises of 5 components as follows:-

- i. Digitization of beneficiary database:- 100 % Ration Cards in the state digitized. Ranking software implemented for categorizing ration cards into four types based on socio-economic indicators. e-Services for Ration cards introduced for 21 Services.
- ii. Supply chain Automation & online allocation:- Online allocation and computerization of Supply Chain Management for delivery of PDS commodities from FCI depots to ARDs.
- iii. Automation of Fair Price shops:- Introduction of ADHAAR enabled POS machine in all the 14292 shops for distribution of ration commodities.

- iv. Grievance Redressal mechanism: - Facility to register complaints online, centralized processing, category based routing of all the complaints to the concerned authority and convenience to the authority in grievance redressal.
- v. Transparency portal:- One point access to all information related to the department.

3. Package for Effective Administration of Registration Laws (PEARL) Project

PEARL provides an end to end integrated application for property registration with e-Stamping, e-Payment, online transfer of revenue registry data for land mutation and online delivery of digitally signed certificate services.
