Notice

In view of representations received from various stakeholders and after careful consideration, the competent authority has come to a decision that the candidates **who remained non allotted till Round 2 of WB NEET UG Medical Dental Counseling process 2026** and who could not pay the security deposit amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- OR Rs. 5,00,000/- as applicable for filling choices in Private Medical and Dental Colleges State Quota and OR Management Quota Seats respectively, wish to fill choice in the Private Medical and Dental Colleges State Quota and OR Management Quota category of Seats, such categories of candidates may send a request mail only from their registered mail id as was mentioned in the NEET data, with a request for initialization of their candidature.

Upon initialization of their candidature such categories of candidates will be made eligible to Re-register their candidature details and payment of registration fee & security deposit money afresh, only from Round 3 onwards.

Interested candidates have to send the request mail in the email id **"westbengalcounselingcell@gmail.com"** from 10 am of 16.09.2026 till 12 midnight of 18.09.2026 only.

Pertinent to mention that such facility is available only in Round 2 as onetime measure without any precedence.

The candidates who had already paid the security deposit amount of Rs. 2,00,000/- for Private College State Quota Seats only, will get back their earlier submitted security deposit money only after completion of the whole counseling process, the registration fee paid earlier would get forfeited for all such candidates.

Needless to mention that in Round 3 onwards, after allotment in any Medical or Dental College, admission is a mandatory process as no seat surrender is allowed from Round 3 onwards. The candidates are instructed to contact the concerned Private College authorities regarding the mode of fees payment as WBMCC shall not be held responsible for Private College fees related issues.
