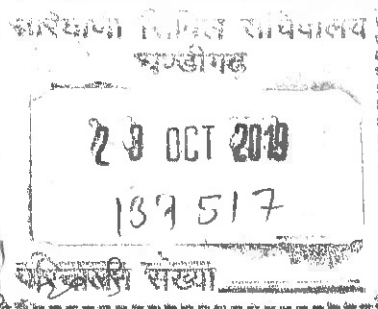

dated 26.08.2019 on the subject cited above and to again inform you that this department intends to fill up the following posts on deputation basis from amongst the officers holding analogous post on regular basis and carrying the same or identical scale.

S.No.	Name of the post and pay scale	No. of posts
1.	Assistant District Attorney in the pay scale of Rs. 10300-34800+4800 Grade Pay	4(four)
2.	Law Officer in the pay scale of Rs. 10300-34800+4200 Grade Pay	3 (three)

The terms and condition of the deputation will be as under:-

1. No official/officer shall be taken on deputation unless he possesses atleast five year regular service as such in his/her parent cadre. It is, however, clarified that regular service shall not include service on adhoc basis but includes probation period.
2. No official/officer shall be taken on deputation who has already attained the age of 55 years.
3. The official /officer shall initially be taken on deputation for a period of one year which shall be extended upto three years or till the direct recruitment to the post is made whichever is earlier.

It is, therefore, again requested to send the panel comprising the names of atleast three suitable officers for each number of posts for both categories alongwith their ACR/APAR dossiers for the last five years and the certificate to the effect that no departmental/vigilance enquiry is contemplated or pending against the said officers.
