noted above.

2. The Government has decided to issue the following guidelines for defending  
and monitoring Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act cases: -

- a) The Senior Most Assistant District Attorney (ADA) of the offices of District Attorney is authorized to conduct trial of cases under Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act at District as well as Sub-Division Level under supervision of Senior most Deputy District Attorney (DDA) and also to designate the Senior Most Assistant District Attorney (ADA) as Panel Law Officer.
- b) The Senior Most Deputy District Attorney (DDA) of the offices of District Attorneys are designated as 'Nodal Officer' to render assistance to the concerned authorities for taking appropriate steps for every action under the Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act so that eventually the action taken under the said Act does not collapse due to technical flaws.
- c) The Senior most Deputy District Attorney (DDA) will submit quarterly report regarding progress of cases of Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act to the concerned District Attorney (DA).
- d) The District Attorney (DA) of each District shall coordinate between Senior Most Deputy District Attorney (Nodal Officer), senior most Assistant District Attorney (Panel Law Officer) and officials responsible for initiation and prosecution of cases under the Pre-Conception and Pre-Natal Diagnostic Techniques Act.

Further, you are requested to issue directions to all the District Attorneys  
for strict compliance of above guidelines in letter and spirit.
