

eCourt Application Demonstration for Quasi Judicial bodies and Revenue Courts at Goa

As per the guidelines from Hon'ble High Court, Advocate General (AG) decided to evaluate the available existing applications from various NIC Centers across India. In view of this a Demo of eCourt Application through VC for Quasi Judicial Bodies and Revenue Court were arranged at NIC, Goa on 29/08/2019 at 17:00 hours. Advocate General, Govt of Goa, Shri Devidas Pangam, Adv. Nikhil Pai, Adv Antonio Clovis da Costa president, South Goa Bar association, Adv. Raviraj Chodankar, Officers from various Quasi Judicial bodies were present for the demonstration. State Informatics Officer Shri Prashant Thete, briefed the purpose of Demo to the forum. Shri Manoj Tuli, Scientist-F from eCourts Division NIC, Delhi demonstrated the complete workflow of application through Video Conferencing. This application has been implemented at National Company Law Tribunal, Delhi.

After that, Shri Kulkarni DIO, Madgaon demonstrated e-Taluka Suite which was catering to the requirement of all revenue court through

VC. As it was brought to the notice that this application cannot be upgraded to the latest technology, AG emphasized that they want a similar type of application with complete workflow, so that it can cater to the requirements of Revenue Courts and all Quasi Judicial Bodies in Goa and must be made available as a Single Portal on similar lines to that of Court Information System (CIS). It was also proposed to take up digitization of old records and integration with CIS in a phased mannered.
