The training was commenced by brief history on ePrison application, timeline of major evolutions, Security features integrated, Nationwide roll-out statistics etc. The training programme was vast and in detail covering all the modules and functionalities of the ePrison Suite. National Prisons Information Portal, Dashboards, eMulakat facility, Citizen services, Prison Administration, Prisoner management, Visitor System configuration, Police management, Intelligence System, Canteen Management, KIOSK etc. were presented to the audience covering the indetailed functionalities in each module. The newly integrated features in ePrison and ICJS related cross functionalities including ICJS admission, Mini statement and Criminal network,



eCustody Certificate production, Bail and release order delivery system, work flow based Parole management - eParole, Aadhaar services etc. were also demonstrated and elaborately explained to the audience during the session.



Queries from the audience were addressed during all sessions and suggestions were given to the concerned officials of Prison Department Goa to mitigate the technical challenges faced by the Department and to plan the implementation strategy for the new initiatives. Necessary directions and suggestions were shared to NIC ICJS Goa officials also to plan the technical actions for the future initiatives.
