#### Eligibility and Documentation Criteria for Student Registration 2021-2021

Eligibility and documentation criteria for admission in class 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>

And Class 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> under Rule 134-A of Haryana School Education Rules, 2003, amended in 2013.

- Children born on or before 1st April 2016 and born on or after 1st April, 2006 will be eligible for admissions to classes 2<sup>nd</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup>.
- Children born on or after 1<sup>st</sup> April 1999 and before 1<sup>st</sup> April 2009 will be eligible for admissions to classes 9<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup>
- No admission will be taken in ongoing Classes 10<sup>th</sup> and 12th
- Only students who are currently studying in Haryana and have a SRN (Student Registration Number) are eligible for admissions under Rule 134A.
- School leaving certificate from the previous school will be mandatory for admission under Rule 134A
- Students with families of income less than or equal to 2,00,000 lakh per annum will be eligible for application under Economically Weaker Section (EWS).

The proof for EWS are:

- Income Certificate from the Tehsildar (Income certificate is valid for 1 year from the date of issue) valid at the time of admission or
- an Affidavit of income from Class 1 Magistrate valid at the time of admission.
- Students from Below Poverty Line (BPL) families can apply with a valid BPL Ration Card.

• Students will require three documents for admission under 134A

### 1. Birth Proof (One of the Following)

- Aadhar Card
- Birth Certificate
- Anganwadi Record
- Hospital/Midwife/Auxiliary Nurse register record
- Affidavit of the date of birth by the parent

## 2. Parent ID Proof (One of the Following)

- Aadhar Card
- Pan Card
- Voter Id
- Passport
- Driving License

## 3. Address Proof (One of the Following)

- Electricity Bill
- Ration card
- Aadhar card
- Domicile
- Passport
- Rent agreement
- The student can select up to 15 schools, 10 in their block of residence and 5 outside the block of residence.

- The minimum eligibility for admission under 134A for **government school students** is 55% marks or above in previous class completed (Academic year 2020-21) examination.
- The minimum eligibility for admission under 134A for **private school students** is 55% marks or above in the assessment examination to be held on 21<sup>st</sup> November. The Assessment Examination will only be conducted for previous class completed for private school students. E.g. Exam will be conducted for Class 4 if a student is applying for class 5.
- No assessment test will be conducted for students applying in Class 11th
- In case of Children in Need of Care and Protection (CNCP) there is no requirement for any documentation of birth proof, parent id and address proof. Orders of the child welfare committee of the concerned district of a child as per the section 50(1) of the Juvenile Justice Act 2015 will be mandatory to avail admission under this category.
- Students are allowed to apply for and take admission in the same private school where they are currently enrolled.
