Dated Panchkula the,

Whereas Takdir Singh approached the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court by way of filing a Civil Writ Petition i.e. CWP No. 16813 of 2021 – Takdir Singh V/s State of Haryana & another praying therein for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned current service profile Annexure P-7 (Updated) of the petitioner to the extent that it depicts GMS Dungreja (6089), Distt. Nuh Mewat as current posting of the petitioner further prayed for necessary changes in current service profile Annexure P-7 (updated) of the petitioner. Thereby depicting GGHS Retauli Kabulpur (2789) Distt. Rohtak as current posting and also further prayed to release salary of the petitioner for the month of April, May, July alongwith August, 2021.

That the above-mentioned case was fixed for hearing on 31.08.2021 and on this date, this Hon'ble High Court was pleased to pass following orders: -

“The petitioner seeks quashing of the impugned current service profile (Annexure P-7), wherein Government Middle School, Dungreja (School Code 6089), District Nuh, Mewat is shown as his current place of posting instead of Government Girls High School, Retauli Kabulpur (School Code 2789), District Rohtak as current place of posting. Further prayer has been made for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the salary of the petitioner for the months of April, May and July, 2021 alongwith the salary of August, 2021.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that on account of the transfer at the school at Mewat, he had approached this Court by filing CWP No. 27387 of 2019, Vijay Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and another, in which, he was arrayed as petitioner no. 6. Initially, stay was granted on 24.09.2019 as he had been transferred to Mewat, which was out of Cadre. Resultantly, the respondents had taken affirmative action on 04.10.2019 (Anexure P-4) and allowed him rejoin back at Rohtak (Annexure P-6). It is submitted that in spite of that, his profile has been wrongly shown, which will adversely effect him also during the Teachers Transfer Drive, which is underway. He further (

points out that the said writ petition has been disposed of on 24.08.2021 in view of CWP No. 15018 of 2021, Vikram Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others, which was also disposed of on the same lines in view of the affidavit of the State alongwith large number of cases. It is submitted that on account of discrepancy in the profile, the school at Rohtak has also written on 03.08.2021 (Annexure P-8) to the concerned authorities for necessary rectification of his portal.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Kirti Singh, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the above, this Court is of the opinion that there is no requirement for the respondents to file reply.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with direction to respondent no. 2 to treat the present writ petition as a representation and take affirmative action on the discrepancy which is shown in the portal in view of the above facts and in view of the judgment in Vikram Singh's case (supra). The aspect of non-payment of salary on account of mistake in the portal shall also be looked into by the said respondent and in case there is any legal impediment as such, speaking order be passed and communicated to the petitioner. Needful be done at the earliest".

In compliance of direction of the Hon'ble Court, the case of the claimant i.e. Sh. Takdir Singh has been examined carefully and it has been found that the claimant was promoted as Elementary School Headmaster vide order No. 15/32-2019 HRM-III (1) dated 24.08.2019 and directed to participate in upcoming transfer drive for promotional post. The claimant had participated in Transfer Drive and opted more than 278 options/preferences in Transfer Drive on 06.09.2019. The claimant had got 51.99 points on MIS portal. It is pertinent to mentioned here that the claimant was posted at Government Middle School, Dungreja (School Code 6089), District Nuh, Mewat as ESHM on promotional post according to his points on MIS portal. It is also relevant to submit that the claimant has also wrongly construed the order dated 06.09.2019 as transfer order whereas it is a promotional adjustment order. As per Transfer Policy, 2016 the answering department has

transferred the employees anywhere in the State and anywhere in the District. The Sub-clause (i) of clause 3 of Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 as under:

(i) Teachers who are members of State Cadre or District Cadre are liable to be transferred anywhere in the State and anywhere in the District, as the case may be, at any point of time.

It is also relevant to submit that the claimant has admitted this fact that his service is governed by the Haryana School Education (Group-C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012 but he failed to consider Rule-12 of the Service Rules, 2012 before approaching this Hon'ble High Court. A kind consideration of Rule-12 would reveal itself that the employee/TGT/ESHM concerned is liable to serve at any place within or outside Haryana on being ordered so to do. The claimant had concealed this fact that the post of ESHM/TGT rationalized from Govt. Senior Secondary Schools and he has been adjusted in adjoining district- Nuh. However, the operative Rule-12 is reproduced herein;

"12. Liability to serve:

- (1) A member of the Service shall be liable to serve at any place, whether within or outside the State of Haryana, on being ordered so to do by the appointing authority.**
- (2) A member of Service appointed by direct recruitment on contract basis shall be liable to serve for a continuous period of five years in the rural area from the date of appointment.**

A member of Service appointed by promotion or by transfer shall be liable to serve for a continuous period of three years in the rural area from the date of such appointment. If not already served for a period of fifteen years in the rural area.


**A member of the Service may also be deputed to serve under,-
a company, an association or a body of individuals whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the State Government,
a municipal corporation or a local authority or university within the State of Haryana; the Central Government or a Company, an association or a body of individuals, whether incorporated or not, which is wholly or substantially owned or controlled by the Central Government; or
any other State Government, an international organization, an autonomous body not controlled by the Government, or a private body:**

L

Provided that no member of the Service shall be deputed to serve the Central or any other State Government or any organization or body referred to clause (ii) or clause (iii) except with his consent.

The claimant has participated in the General Transfer Drive on 06.09.2019 for posting at promotional post as Elementary School Headmaster and he was posted at Government Middle School, Dungreja (School Code 6089), District Nuh, Mewat from Government Girls High School, Retauli Kabulpur (School Code 2789), District Rohtak. Thereafter, the claimant alongwith some other employees filed a Civil Writ Petition No. 27387 of 2019 titled as Vijay Kumar and others Vs. State of Haryana and others. In which the Hon'ble High Court granted stay to the claimant and in compliance of that stay order the claimant was allowed to re-join at his previous station from he was relieved i.e. Government Girls High School, Retauli Kabulpur (School Code 2789), District Rohtak.

It is worthwhile to mention here that the answering department had updated the MIS profile of all such employees who received stay order from the Hon'ble High Court, so that they would stay at their previous station in compliance of direction of the Hon'ble High Court till the final decision of the court and upcoming transfer drive will not muddle the stay order of the Hon'ble High Court. Some of the petitioners/ claimant has filed a CWP No. 15018 of 2021, Vikram Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others which was disposed off alongwith many writ petitions which were pending with the Hon'ble High Court regarding the stay in transfer drive. The CWP No. 27387 of 2019, Vijay Kumar and others vs. State of Haryana and another was also dispose off alongwith the said writ petition and the profile of the claimant has been updated by the answering department so that he can be participated in upcoming transfer drive as per the policy.

Keeping in view the controversy involved in later part of prayer of the present writ petition a letter was written to the concerned DEEO Rohtak to release the salary of the claimant for month of April, May, July alongwith August, 2021. As per the information received from DEEO Rohtak the salary of the claimant has been released vide letter No. E-1-22/41 dated 21.02.2022 and the compliance of the direction dated 31.08.2021 has been made by releasing the salary of the claimant as well as to allow him to participate in upcoming transfer drive. 

Besides above, the case of claimant has been examined by the competent authority and it has been found that the claimant has wrongly construed the order dated 06.09.2019 as transfer order whereas it is a promotional adjustment order. However, keeping in view of the direction issued by the Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 15018 of 2021, Vikram Singh and others vs. State of Haryana and others, the claimant will be allowed to participated in upcoming transfer drive as well as salary of the claimant is also released by authority. Therefore, in view of the above background and factual position of the case, the claim of the claimant is fulfilled/gratified.

Order accordingly.
