Whereas Smt. Gita Chauhan (ID-5013354) W/o Sh. Randeep Singh, TGT S.S. (Guest) has approached the Hon'ble High Court by way of filing a writ petition i.e. CWP No. 4183 of 2023 titled as Gita Chauhan Vs. State of Haryana & others praying therein for the issuance of an appropriate writ , order or direction as this Hon'ble Court may deem fit in the facts and circumstances of the case, especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant 05 points for transfer of couple case basis under the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 as amended from time to time and further consider her case for transfer against the vacant positions instead of giving posting to the teachers registered under Haryana KaushalRozgar Nigam Limited and In alternate direct the respondents to consider and decide the claim made out in the legal notice dated 27.12.2022 (Annexure P/12) followed by final legal notice dated 20.01.2023 (Annexure P/13) by passing a well reasoned and speaking orders within stipulated time as may be fixed by this Hon'ble Court after affording an opportunity of personal hearing to the claimant.

The above mentioned civil writ petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on dated 02.03.2023 and the Hon'ble Court was pleased to dispose of the same with directions to respondents. The operative part of order dated 02.03.2023 is as under:

“The petitioner has preferred this writ petition for the issuance of an appropriate writ, order or direction, especially in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant five points for transfer of couple case basis under the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 as amended from time to time.

The petitioner has prayed that a case for transfer against the vacant posts be considered instead of posting her under the Haryana Kaushal Rozgar Nigam Limited. In the writ petition, the petitioner has pleaded factual details in respect of her final representation for uploading the MIS portal for inclusion of the

employees working in the Haryana School Sikhsha Pariyojna Parishad for the purpose of grant of fivepoints to the female employees on couple case basis.

Precisely, for the grievance in question, the petitioner has also served a legal notice upon the respondents/competent authority. The legal notice was again supplemented by the final legal notice dated 20.01.2023.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case her legal notice dated 20.01.2023 (served upon the respondent No.3) is ordered to be considered and decided by the competent authority in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State and submits that the legal notice dated 20.01.2023 served by the petitioner upon the competent authority shall be considered and decided in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Disposed of.”

Whereas, the Government of Haryana has framed **Teachers Transfer Policy, 2016** (amended from time to time). Thereupon, transfers were made under this amended policy of 2017 to ensure equitable, demand based distribution of teachers/Heads to protect academic interests of students and optimize job satisfaction amongst its employees in a fair and transparent manner.

That in compliance of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 02.03.2022 the Legal notice dated 20.01.2023 and 27.12.2022 have been examined and found that the claimant has raised her claim that she has not been awarded 5 points on couple case basis. The claimant further submitted that due to not awarding of 5 points on account of couple case she got only 52.69 Marks/Points, whereas, if at all 5 points would have been awarded under the category of couple case, the claimant would have been given total 57.69 Marks/Points.

In regard to the claim raised by the claimant in her representation/Legal Notice, it is hereby stated that marks as per the transfer policy the 5 points of couple case has been awarded to only those female employees whose spouse are working under regular employment in state govt., center Govt, PSUs created under

acts or rules only and not to those whose spouse are working on ad-hoc basis OR contractual Employee. Further, Rule 8 (36) of HCS (GENERAL) RULES, 2016 clearly provides that person appointed on contract basis shall not come under the definition of government employee and the said rule is reproduced as under:-

Rule 8 (36) "Government employee" except as otherwise provided in these rules of any other rules means a member of State Services Group A, B, C or D whose—

- (i) conditions of service are regulated by rules made by the Governor of Haryana under the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India;
- (ii) appointment is made on regular basis in connection with the affairs of Government of Haryana; and
- (iii) pay is debited to Consolidated Fund of the State of Haryana except when serving on foreign service or deputation; but it shall not include persons—
 - (1) in casual or daily-rated or part-time employment;
 - (2) paid from contingencies/contingent charges;
 - (3) of work-charged establishment; and
 - (4) appointed on contract basis;

As per Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016 (Amended as on 01.06.2017) the relevant provision for merit criteria for allotment of posts given in point no. 7 and the relevant part of the table with respect to couple case point is reproduced as under :-

7.	Couple case	Only female spouse	5	Employees' spouses working in state govt., center Govt, PSUs created under acts or rules.

As admitted by the claimant in her writ petition that her husband is working as Vocational Teacher for Retail Skills on purely contract basis under centrally sponsored scheme/project of "Vocationalization of Higher Secondary Education in Alignment with NVEQF" posted in GSSS Narwana District Jind. Thus, the husband of the complainant is a contractual employee and not a regular government employee. Therefore, husband of the petitioner does not fall under the

definition of government employee as mentioned above. Thus, the claimant is not entitled for 5 points on account of couple case as her husband is a contractual employee. Hence, the claim of the claimant is not as per policy. At this juncture, it is pertinent to mention here that all guest teachers were treated equally in the light of Section 5 clause (3) of Haryana Guest Teachers Service Act, 2019. Hence, they can be transferred at any school throughout the State of Haryana (any of 22 Districts of Haryana). In other words, unlike regular teachers, guest teachers do not fall under State/District Cadre and as such they can be transferred/posted throughout the State of Haryana.


It is also stated here that, a government employee or any servant of a Public Service has no legal right to insist for being posted at any particular place and the same has also been upheld by the Hon'ble Apex court on 06.09.2021 in SLP No. 36717 of 2017 in CWP no. 48447 of 2017 in which the Hon'ble Apex Court has held that *"it is not for the employee to insist to transfer him/her and/or not to transfer him/ her at a particular place. It is for the employer to transfer an employee considering the employment."*

Further, the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in its judgment dated 14.11.2022 in CWP No. 22233 of 2022 titled as *AunkariYadav and others V/s State of Haryana and others by placing a reliance on the judgement dated 10.03.2022 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.1243 of 2022 titled as S.K NausadRahaman and others vs. Union of India and others, and judgment dated 24.02.2020 of Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in LPA No.247 of 2020 titled as Nisha vs. State of Haryana has specifically held that the transfer policy is not justiciable and no right is created with an employee to claim a benefit under the transfer policy.*

In view of the above narrated facts and circumstances the claim of the claimant in the legal notices dated 27.12.2022 and 20.01.2023 is not tenable as per

law, as such transfers have been done as per the provisions of the policy.
Accordingly, the claim of claimant is hereby rejected.

Ordered accordingly.



Whereas Sh. Naveen Yadav (ID 5012552) Guest TGT S.S. Master, presently working in GSSS Multhan, Nuh Mewat has approached the Hon'ble High Court by way of filing a writ petition i.e. CWP No. 27364 of 2022 titled as Naveen Yadav Vs. State of Haryana & another praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned Transfer List Annexure P-7 (Not Dated) released on 22.11.2022 and a writ in the nature of mandamus whereby directing the respondents to consider the representation dated 09.11.2022 (Annexure P-8) and prepare an amended merit list for allotment of Gurugram district as the petitioner is eligible for the same.

Whereas, the Hon'ble High Court has clubbed together the above mentioned writ petition filed by the Sh. Naveen Yadav and other writ petitions bearing same cause of action. Thereafter, the Hon'ble High Court has passed a common order dated 30.11.2022. The operative part of order dated 30.11.2022 is as under:-

“Mr. Harish Nain, Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the representations of the petitioner(s), if already filed or submitted by the petitioner(s) within a period of three days from today, will be considered and decided within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioner(s) submit that once the respondents have undertaken to decide the grievance raised in the representations, in order to avoid the harassment, the petitioner(s) be allowed to continue at their present place of posting till the decision

of the said representations so that in case, tomorrow their grievance is accepted, they are not uprooted again so as to cause further inconvenience to the teachers.

Keeping in view the above, it is directed that till the decision of representations already filed by the petitioner(s) or filed till Friday, petitioner(s) will be allowed to continue at the present place of posting. It is made clear that in case, petitioner(s) have already been relieved, they will be allowed to join back at the same place of posting till the decision.

It is made clear that this Court is not making any observation with regard to the legality or illegality of the transfer at this stage and the respondents will be free to decide the representations filed by the petitioner (s) in accordance with the facts of each case whether, the dislocation of the petitioner(s) is on account of joining of a regular employee or being surplus as informed to this Court by the learned counsel for the respondents keeping in view the information supplied by the department to the learned State counsel.

All the writ petitions stand disposed of in above terms.

Whereas, the Government of Haryana has framed **Teachers Transfer Policy, 2016** (amended from time to time). Thereupon, transfers were made under this amended policy of 2017 to ensure equitable, demand based distribution of teachers/Heads to protect academic interests of students and optimize job satisfaction amongst its employees in a fair and transparent manner.

Whereas, it is pertinent to mention that it has been ensured by the department that till the passing of the present speaking orders, no petitioners will be relieved or forced to join new place of posting and an order dated 29.11.2022 has been passed by the department in this regard.

That in compliance of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 30.11.2022, the representation of the representationist/petitioner has been examined in view of the provisions of the Teacher Transfer Policy, 2016. (as amended from time to time). While examining the representation dated 09.11.2022 (Annexure P-8), it has come into light that the representationist/petitioner Sh. Naveen Yadav (ID 5012552) has claimed that he was working as Guest (TGT S.S. Master) in GSSS Kalwari (799), District Mewat after that he transferred to GMS Uleta (722), District Nuh Mewat in Mewat Cadre and again he transferred to GSSS Multhan, Nuh Mewat. The Petitioner has filed the representation dated 09.11.2022 stating therein that he has participated in General Transfer Drive 2022 and has filled online station for transfer drive 2022. Thereafter, the clamant participated and filled up choices during the first round of transfer drive and was allocated station in accordance with his points on MIS vide order dated 11.09.2022. The petitioner was relieved and joined at new station GSSS Multhan, Nuh Mewat.

Subsequently to the transfer drive conducted for Guest Teachers in September, 2022, various representations were received by the Department. After due consideration, it was decided to conduct another transfer drive for Guest Teacher and the same was concluded in November, 2022.

As per record, it is found that Sh. Naveen Yadav (5012552) had opted Gurugram as his Home/Single district choice. As per MIS portal Sh. Naveen Yadav had got only 38.7014 marks/points for transfer drive and the cut off in Gurugram District for S.S. Guest Teacher was 43.4164. Thereafter, he was marked for round-2 because of Non-availability of vacancy which were offered to guest teachers during their re-adjustment in home district. It is notable here that in second round cut off in Gurugram District for S.S. Guest Teacher was 42.3616 points/marks and during round-2 he opted 10 districts and got Mewat as his 3rd choice. It is relevant to state here that district Mewat is one of Sh. Naveen Yadav

choice out of 10 districts which he opted in round-2. District Elementary Education Officer Mewat has posted him in GSSS Nai (Mewat/Nuh). In regard to the representation made by the claimant, it is hereby stated that as per policy only those posts which remained unfilled by regular teachers were offered to Guest Teachers.


At this juncture, it is pertinent to mention here that all guest teachers were treated equally in the light of Section 5 clause (3) of Haryana Guest Teachers Service Act, 2019. Hence, they can be transferred at any school throughout the State of Haryana (any of 22 Districts of Haryana). In other words, unlike regular teachers, guest teachers do not fall under State/District Cadre and as such they can be transferred/posted throughout the State of Haryana.

It is also submitted here that, a government employee or any servant of a Public Service has no legal right to insist for being posted at any particular place and the same has also been upheld by the Hon'ble Apex court on 06.09.2021 in SLP No. 36717 of 2017 in CWP no. 48447 of 2017 in which the Hon'ble Apex Court has held that *"it is not for the employee to insist to transfer him/her and/or not to transfer him/ her at a particular place. Further, the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in its judgment dated 14.11.2022 in CWP No. 22233 of 2022 titled as *Aunkari Yadav and others V/s State of Haryana and others* by placing a reliance on *the judgement dated 10.03.2022 of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in Civil Appeal No.1243 of 2022 titled as S.K Nausad Rahaman and others vs. Union of India and others*, and *judgment dated 24.02.2020 of Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court in LPA No.247 of 2020 titled as Nisha vs. State of Haryana* has specifically held that *the transfer policy is not justiciable and no right is created with an employee to claim a benefit under the transfer policy.*

In view of the above narrated facts, I undersigned, is of the considered view that the claim of the representationist/petitioner is not tenable as such transfers have been done as per the provisions of the policy and as per reasons cited *supra*. Therefore, there are no merits in representation of the representationist/petitioner and the same is hereby rejected accordingly.

Ordered accordingly.


