Whereas Sh. Rajesh Kumar Sanskrit Teacher approached the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court by way of filing a Civil Writ Petition i.e. CWP No. 4403 of 2020 -Rajesh Kumar V/s State of Haryana & other praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent No. 2 to promote the petitioner prior to and over & above the private respondents No. 4 to 7 with all consequential benefit as other juniors were promoted vide order dated 01.12.2016 (Annexure P-6) passed by respondent No. 2 vide which the persons much juniors to the petitioner have been promoted from the post of Sanskrit Teachers (now TGT Sanskrit) to the post of Elementary School Headmaster (ESHM).

The said petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 21.11.2022 and on that day Hon'ble High Court was pleased to dispose of with direction to respondents. The operative part of the order dated 21.11.2022 is as under:-

"Learned counsel for the respondents submits that after issuance of seniority list in the year 2019, certain candidates have been issued show cause notice as to why their promotion should not be recalled, which show cause notice is already subject matter of litigation before this Court in CWP No.2200 of 2022, titled as Shakti Dhar Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and another.

Learned counsel submits that as there is an interim order in the abovementioned petition with regard to taking appropriate decision on the show cause notice, no further decision could be taken with regard to the claim of the petitioners for promotion till the said show cause notice are decided.

As the writ petitions, details of which are being given by the respondents due to which no action has been taken with regard to the claim of the petitioners for promotion to the post of Elementary School Headmaster, keeping in view the seniority list issued in the year 2019 have already been disposed of today, direction is issued to the respondents that after the decision of show cause notice issued therein to the employees is passed by the respondents authorities, in case the claim of the petitioners for promotion still subsists, the same be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order be passed within a period of eight weeks and in case the petitioners are found entitled for promotion, the same be also extended to them within a further period of four weeks."

In the compliance of above mentioned direction, the claim of claimant has been examined at length, it is found that the claimant was initially appointed as JBT on 28.01.1999 and thereafter promoted as Sanskrit Teacher on 04.06.2007. The claimant has passed B.A. with 60.50% from Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra in year 1999 and B.Ed. with C.G.P.A. 3.45 from IGNOU, Delhi in year 2003. The claimant is working as Sanskrit Teacher with seniority no. 2713 whereas respondent No. 4 to 7 at seniority No. 2716, 2722, 2720, and 2723 respectively in seniority list dated 15.01.2019. It is worthwhile to mention here that the private respondent No. 4 to 7 were promoted in the compliance of direction issued by the Hon'ble High Court and separately no promotion cases were invited and considered for promotion to the post of ESHM

from Sanskrit Teacher has been made by the department till today. It is relevant to state here that a show cause notice was issued vide order No. 17/4-2022 ESHM (1) Dated 03.03.2023/09.03.2023 by this Department in compliance of Hon'ble High Court orders dated 21.11.2022 in CWP No. 2200 of 2022 namely Shakti Dhar Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and others alongwith other similar matters which came up for adjudication before the Hon'ble High Court on 21.11.2022 and same was disposed of with following order:-

"By this common order, the writ petitions, details of which have been given above, are being disposed of as all the writ petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that though a show cause notice has been issued with regard to the reversion from the post of Elementary School Headmaster to that of Sanskrit Teacher but as of now no action has been taken.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that only apprehension of the petitioners is that the respondents might not appreciate all the reasons which the petitioners have so as to justify their promotion to the post of Elementary School Headmaster including the fact, which is being raised here that there are certain seniors, who are ineligible to hold the post of Elementary School Headmaster.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the said arguments only bring out apprehension and not the fact. Whatever justification the petitioners will raise qua the show cause notice, the same will be considered in accordance with law coupled with the Rules governing the service and then appropriate order on the show cause notice issued to the petitioners, will be passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the said statement of the counsel for the respondents, the petition be disposed of as having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate reply to the show cause notice, which has been issued to the petitioners proposing the reversion to the post of Sanskrit Teacher.


Ordered accordingly."

In compliance of above said orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the department issued Show Cause Notices vide order No. 17/4-2022 ESHM (1) Dated 03.03.2023/09.03.2023 to 135 Elementary School Headmasters promoted from Sanskrit Teachers including the respondent No. 4 to 7 who are not falling in the seniority list dated 15.01.2019 as per sanctioned posts. Some of ESHMs promoted from Sanskrit Teachers challenged the said Show Cause Notice alongwith the amendment which was issued recently vide official notification dated 15.03.2022 Service Rules, 2012 w.r.t. promotion to the post of ESHM in CWP No. 5886 of 2023 namely Sartaj Singh Dhanda and others Vs. State of Haryana and others. Thereafter, an another Civil Writ Petition No. 6366 of 2023 titled as Rattan Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others has been filed and the Hon'ble Court was pleased to stay the operation and implementation of the corrigendum issued vide order No. 15/12-2019 HRM-III/ESHM (1) dated 01.07.2022 and also stay of all further action pursuant to the Show Cause Notice for reversion.

Keeping in view position explained above, the claim of claimant will be considered at the time when the promotion will be made on the post of Elementary School Head Master after the vacation of stay or final decision of the Hon'ble Court in aforementioned writ petitions with respect to Show Cause Notices dated 09.03.2023 to concerned ESHM's. Hence, at present the

claim of the claimant is hereby kept pending till the final decision of the Hon'ble High Court in aforesaid mentioned writ petition and vacation of stay in above terms.

Whereas Sh. Babru Bhan and others Sanskrit Teachers approached the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court by way of filing a Civil Writ Petition i.e. CWP No.9885 of 2019 – Babru Bhan and others V/s State of Haryana & other praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the promotion order dated 01.12.2016 (Annexure P-1) passed by the respondent no: 2 vide which some TGT Sanskrit/ Sanskrit Teachers who are junior to the petitioners have been promoted as Elementary School Headmaster and the further quashing the posting order dated 04.09.2017 (Annexure P-2). Further prayed for quashing the order dated 06.07.2018 vide which the just and genuine claim of the petitioners has been rejected for promotion to the post of ESHM.

The said petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 21.11.2022 and on that day Hon'ble High Court was pleased to dispose of with direction to respondents. The operative part of the order dated 21.11.2022 is as under:-

“Learned counsel for the respondents submits that after issuance of seniority list in the year 2019, certain candidates have been issued show cause notice as to why their promotion should not be recalled, which show cause notice is already subject matter of litigation before this Court in CWP No.2200 of 2022, titled as Shakti Dhar Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and another.

Learned counsel submits that as there is an interim order in the abovementioned petition with regard to taking appropriate decision on the show cause notice, no further decision could be taken with regard to the claim of the petitioners for promotion till the said show cause notices are decided.

As the writ petitions, details of which are being given by the respondents due to which no action has been taken with regard to the claim of the petitioners for promotion to the post of Elementary School Headmaster, keeping in view the seniority list issued in the year 2019 have already been disposed of today, direction is issued to the respondents that after the decision of show cause notice issued therein to the employees is passed by the respondents authorities, in case the claim of the petitioners for promotion still subsists, the same be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order be passed within a period of eight weeks and in case the petitioners are found entitled for promotion, the same be also extended to them within a further period of four weeks.”

In the compliance of above mentioned direction, the claim of claimants has been examined at length, it is found that the claimants are working as Sanskrit Teachers. The details of academic record and seniority of the claimants are as under:-

In the reference of second payer clause, it is submitted that the claimants are working as Sanskrit Teachers with seniority as mentioned above whereas respondent No. 3 to 29 are junior as per their respective seniority in seniority list dated 15.01.2019. It is worthwhile to mention here that the private respondent No. 3 to 29 were promoted in the compliance of direction issued by the Hon'ble High Court and separately no promotion cases were invited and considered for promotion to the post of ESHM from Sanskrit Teacher till today. It is relevant to state here that a show cause notice was issued to respondent No. 3 to 29 alongwith other similar ESHMs promoted from Sanskrit Teachers vide order No. 17/4-2022 ESHM (1) Dated 03.03.2023/09.03.2023 by this Department in compliance of Hon'ble High Court orders dated 21.11.2022 in CWP No. 2200 of 2022 namely Shakti Dhar Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and others alongwith other similar matters which came up for adjudication before the Hon'ble High Court on 21.11.2022 and same was disposed of with following order:-

"By this common order, the writ petitions, details of which have been given above, are being disposed of as all the writ petitions involve the same question of law on similar facts.

Learned counsel for the petitioners very fairly submits that though a show cause notice has been issued with regard to the reversion from the post of Elementary School Headmaster to that of Sanskrit Teacher but as of now no action has been taken.

In compliance of above said orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the department issued Show Cause Notices vide order No. 17/4-2022 ESHM (1) Dated 03.03.2023/09.03.2023 to 135 Elementary School Headmasters promoted from Sanskrit Teachers including the respondent No. 3 to 29, who are not falling in the seniority list dated 15.01.2019 as per sanctioned posts. Some of ESHMs promoted from Sanskrit Teachers challenged the said Show Cause Notice alongwith the amendment which was issued recently vide official notification dated 15.03.2022 Service Rules, 2012 w.r.t. promotion to the post of ESHM in CWP No. 5886 of 2023 namely Sartaj Singh Dhanda and others Vs. State of Haryana and others. Thereafter, an another Civil Writ Petition No. 6366 of

2023 titled as Rattan Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others has been filed and the Hon'ble Court was pleased to stay the operation and implementation of the corrigendum issued vide order No. 15/12-2019 HRM-III/ESHM (1) dated 01.07.2022 and also stay of all further action pursuant to the Show Cause Notice for reversion.

Keeping in view position explained above, the claim of claimants will be considered at the time when the promotion will be made on the post of Elementary School Head Master after the vacation of stay or final decision of the Hon'ble Court in aforementioned writ petitions with respect to Show Cause Notices dated 09.03.2023 to concerned ESHM's. Hence, at present the claim of the claimants are hereby kept pending till the final decision of the Hon'ble High Court in aforesaid mentioned writ petition and vacation of stay in above terms.



Whereas, the present CWP No. 1932 of 2023 titled as Jagdeep Kumar V/s State of Haryana & Others was filed by the petitioner praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for quashing the action of the Respondents in promoting the persons juniors to the petitioner from post of Master Cadre to the post of Elementary School vide order dated 09.11.2020 (Annexure P-9) leaving behind the petitioner who is much senior to them.

Further prayed for directing the Respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Elementary School Headmaster over and above his junior counterparts w.e.f. 24.08.2019 in light of the submissions made herein below in the present writ petition with all consequential benefits including seniority, arrears of salary etc. alongwith interest @ 18%

The said petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 01.02.2023 and the following order was passed.

"Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been working as a Math Master, and that while passing the order dated 09.11.2020 (Annexure P-9), seniority of the petitioner has been ignored and respondents No.3 and 4, who are juniors to the petitioner, have been promoted to the posts of the Elementary School Headmasters in HES-III (School Cadre) in the Grade of Rs.9300- 34800+4800 Grade Pay

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already sent a legal notice dated 14.12.2022 (Annexure P12) to the official respondent, which is still pending consideration and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said legal notice.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only, at this stage.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. R. S. Budhwar, Addl. A. G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 14.12.2022 (Annexure P12) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 14.12.2022 (Annexure P-12) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.."

In compliance of the direction issued by the Hon'ble High Court, the legal notice dated 14.12.2022 (Annexure P12) of the claimant has been examined in depth and the detail of all the claimant along with his respective seniority is as under:-

After examining the entire record, it has been found that the claimant is having B.A. with 51.08% & B.Ed. with 51.3% in 1997 from Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra. It is worthwhile to mention here that the department has made promotions on the post of Elementary School Head Master on the basis of seniority list TGT/Master Cadre as on 01.01.2017 by which TGT/Master had been promoted Seniority upto 4500 (General) and upto


10000 reserved category as per Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012.

It is stated here that the claimant i.e. Sh. Jagdeep Kumar, Math Master has mentioned his Seniority as 4721 and seniority number 4722 of respondent No. 3 and Seniority No. 5152 of respondent No. 4 in instant writ petition which is not correct. The petitioner is at seniority number 4663 and respondent no 3 & 4 are at seniority No. 4272 and 4424 respectively in the seniority list dated 01.01.2017. After due examination the Legal Notice/writ petition it is found that the claimant is trying to mislead the Hon'ble High Court as well as department by giving wrong facts.

In the view of above, it is significant/emphatically stated that the claimant (Seniority No. 4663) is much junior to the respondent No. 3 and respondent No. 4 as they are mentioned at Seniority No. 4272 & 4424 respectively in seniority list of TGT/Master Cadre as on 01.01.2017.

In the context explained above, the case of the claimant has been examined and it has found that the claimant is not eligible for promotion at present as the department had promoted TGTs/Masters up to Seniority No. 4500 (General) on the post of Elementary School Head Master on the basis of seniority list of TGT/Master Cadre as on 01.01.2017 and as per Service Rules, 2012. The promotion case of the claimant will be considered at his turn as per his respective seniority in seniority list dated 01.01.2017 and as per Service Rules, 2012. On the basis of present circumstances, the claim of the claimants has been rejected in above terms.

I order accordingly.

Whereas Sh. Shamsheer Singh Sanskrit Teacher approached the Hon'ble Punjab & Haryana High Court by way of filing a Civil Writ Petition i.e. CWP No.24638 of 2021 -Shamsheer SinghV/s State of Haryana &Another praying therein for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 23.09.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.2 whereby the representation dated 06.02.2021 (Annexure P-2) has been rejected in by holding that promotion of the juniors will be reverted if they do not fall under the seniority list dated 15.01.2019, but no action has been taken. Further directing the respondents to promote the petitioner as Elementary School Head Master (ESHM) and fix his seniority above the juniors from 01.04.2016.

The said petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 21.11.2022 and on that day Hon'ble High Court was pleased to dispose of with direction to respondents. The operative part of the order dated 21.11.2022 is as under:-

"Learned counsel for the respondents submits that after issuance of seniority list in the year 2019, certain candidates have been issued show cause notice as to why their promotion should not be recalled, which show cause notice is already subject matter of litigation before this Court in CWP No.2200 of 2022, titled as Shakti Dhar Sharma and others Vs. State of Haryana and another.

Learned counsel submits that as there is an interim order in the abovementioned petition with regard to taking appropriate decision on the show cause notice, no further decision could be taken with regard to the claim of the petitioners for promotion till the said show cause notice are decided.

In compliance of above said orders of the Hon'ble High Court, the department issued Show Cause Notices vide order No. 17/4-2022 ESHM (1) Dated 03.03.2023/09.03.2023 to 135 Elementary School Headmasters promoted from Sanskrit Teachers, who are not falling in the seniority list dated 15.01.2019 as per sanctioned posts.

That in view of the submissions made above, the case of the claimant i.e. Shamsheer Singh was examined and it has been found that initially the claimant was appointed as JBT on 16.11.1995. Thereafter, the claimant was promoted as Sanskrit Teacher vide order No. E-2-03/1395-1399 dated 22.12.2003. He has passed B.A. with 60% in 1984 from KUK and B.Ed. with 50.89% in 1987 from MDU, Rohtak.

As per Rules, 2012, the academic qualification and experience for the post of ESHM is as under :

- 1. BA/B.Sc. with at least 50% marks and one year Bachelor in Education**
- 2. 5 years experience in regular capacity as Sanskrit teacher.**

In view of the above the academic record of the claimant is as under:

It is also pertinent to mention here that recently vide official notification dated 15.03.2022 Service Rules, 2012 w.r.t. promotion to the post of ESHM have been amended and the promotion case of claimant will be called and considered as per the sanctioned posts, seniority list

dated 15.01.2019 and as per the existing Service Rules, 2012 and also after the final decision on the Show Cause Notices of such ESHMs' who were promoted without seniority list and subject to review/cancellation in case of any discrepancy regarding eligibility/seniority is found as well as subject to condition that no prejudice to the right of seniors, if any whose promotion case may be decided at later stage. The seniority list of Sanskrit Teachers for the promotion on the post of Elementary School Head Master came into existence on 15.01.2019 and promotion cases of the eligible senior Sanskrit teacher will be considered at his turn on the basis of seniority list dated 15.01.2019, available vacancies and existing Service Rules (amendment notification dated 15.03.2022).

Keeping in view position explained above, the case of claimant has been examined and it has been found that the claimant is at seniority No. 2168 in the seniority list dated 15.01.2019. The promotion case of the claimant will be considered at the time when the promotion will be made on the post of Elementary School Head Master after the final decision on Show Cause Notices dated 09.03.2023 to concerned ESHM's. Hence, at present the claim of the claimant is hereby rejected in above terms.

Order accordingly.
