Whereas, the present CWP No. 10196 of 2024 Rohtash Singh Vs. State of Haryana & Others was filed in the Hon'ble High Court for directing the respondent-Department to step up his pay at par with his junior respondent No.3, who is very much junior to the petitioner and getting more salary as compared to the petitioner. Further prayed for directing the respondent department to decide his representation dated 30.01.2024 (Annexure P-8).

The said writ petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 06.05.2024 and Hon'ble High Court was pleased to disposed of present writ petition. The operative part of the order is reproduced as under:-

*"Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case the representation dated 30.01.2024 (Annexure P-8) has been received in the office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order. Learned counsel further submits that in case, it is found feasible to accept the claim of the petitioner, the same will be accepted, otherwise due reasons will be mentioned for not accepting the claim of the petitioner in the speaking order to be passed. 6.*

*In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 30.01.2024 (Annexure P-8) within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order."*

In the compliance of above direction, the representation dated 30.01.2024 annexed as Annexure P-8 of the representationist was examined carefully as per office record and after examining the representation, it has been found that the representationist was appointed on the post of Master on dated 19.11.1991 in the General Category. Thereafter, the representationist was promoted as ESHM on 13.06.2013. After perusing the record of the representationist it is found that he is not qualified for the promotion due to the reason that "he secured less than 50% marks in B.A. in the light the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012". Further, the representationist himself admitted at para no. 4 of his writ petition that respondent no. 3 belongs to reserve category and as such posts were available in the reserve Quota the respondent no. 3 i.e. Ramesh Kumar was promoted to the post of ESHM on dated 28.11.1997 since the respondent no. 3 was covered/governed by Haryana Civil Service Rules 1998. The representationist could not be promoted on the post of Middle Head Master at the time when Ramesh Kumar was promoted because of the fact that the representationist belongs to General Category and no post was available for

General Category. The representationist was promoted on the post of Middle Head master on 13.06.2013 and at that time the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012 were applicable therefore the promotion matter of the representationist is subject to the criteria fixed under the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012.

Whereas, the educational qualifications for the post of Elementary School Head Master are very much clear under Appendix-B of the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012. In the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012; no employee who is on the post of TGT is exempted from having requirement provided under Appendix B of Rules, 2012 for promotion as Elementary School Head Master (ESHM) which is as under :-

Whereas, the departmental committee had submitted in his report that the representationist is not eligible for promotion as per the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012 (Appendix - B) due to less than 50% marks in B.A., i.e. 339/700 which is less than 50% marks.

Whereas the department is bound by the Law, Rules, Regulation, Instructions, Notification and Decision passed by the Hon'ble Apex Court. However, the representationist demand notice/representation is found to be devoid of merits as per the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012 (Appendix - B) as well as notification issued by the State Government on dated 05.03.2009/16.03.2009 as the representationist failed to match the qualification criteria fixed at the time of his promotion as per the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012 and his request for stepping up of his pay at par with his junior counter-part i.e. respondent no. 3 i.e. Ramesh Kumar is unjustified for the reasons stated above. The representationist was not eligible for the promotion to the post of ESHM w.r.t. that the matter has already brought to the notice of higher authority/competent authority for approval regarding further action in accordance with law.

It is hereby directed that the claim made in the representation dated 30.01.2024 is not maintainable as per record and hereby rejected.

State of Haryana & Others was filed in the Hon'ble High Court for directing the respondent-Department to step up his pay at par with his junior respondent No.3, who is very much junior to the petitioner and getting more salary as compared to the petitioner. Further prayed for directing the respondent department to decide his representation dated 01.02.2024 (Annexure P-7).

The said writ petition came up for hearing before the Hon'ble High Court on 28.05.2024 and Hon'ble High Court was pleased to disposed of present writ petition. The operative part of the order is reproduced as under:-

*"In view thereof, without going into merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2/Director of Elementary Education, Haryana, to consider and decide the pending representation, dated 01.02.2024, Annexure P-7, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law, within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.*

*In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹25,000 to the petitioner."*

In the compliance of above direction, the representation dated 01.02.2024 annexed as Annexure P-7 of the representationist was examined carefully and approval was sought from competent authority to call the record from the DEEO Hisar, and after examining the representation, it has been found that the claimant Sh. Jaswant Singh was appointed on the post of Master on dated 28.10.1991 in the General Category. After perusing the office record of the representationist, it was found that he is not qualified for promotion to the post of ESHM due to the reason that he is not eligible for promotion as per the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012 (Appendix - B) due to having less than 50% marks in B.A., i.e. 314/700 which is less than 50% marks.

Whereas, the educational qualifications for the post of Elementary School Head Master are very much clear under Appendix-B of the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012. In the Haryana School Education (Group C) State Cadre Service Rules, 2012; no employee who is on the post of TGT is exempted from having requirement provided under Appendix B of Rules, 2012 for promotion as Elementary School Head Master (ESHM)

**Terms and conditions: -**

1. The candidates are appointed purely on provisional/temporary basis. This appointment is against temporary post and their confirmation against substantive post shall be considered on the basis of their seniority, record of service and as and when such post is available.
2. The candidates shall have to take an oath of allegiance to the Constitution of India before issuance of regular appointment letter.
3. The candidates shall not claim seniority on the basis of this order. Their inter-se seniority will be decided in accordance with the relevant service rules and instructions of the State Government issued from time to time.
4. The appointment will be subject to the final outcome of the pending court case(s), if any.
5. The candidates shall remain on probation for a period of two years, extendable upto three years as per rules 27 of HCS (General) Rules, 2016.
6. In the matters, not specifically mentioned in this communication, the candidates shall be governed by the Haryana Civil Services Rules-2016 as applicable to Haryana Government Employee and such orders/ instructions as may be issued by the Government from time to time.
7. In case of reserved category candidates, the appointment is provisional and is subject to verification of the Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled tribes/Backward Class and ESM Category Certificate. If the verification reveals that the claim of belonging to SC/ST/BC and ESM, as the case may be is false then their





- service will be terminated forthwith without assigning any further reason and without prejudice to such further action as may be taken under provisions of the Indian Penal Code for production of false certificate.
8. The candidates shall be governed by the Haryana State Education School Cadre (Group-C) Service Rules, 2012(amended from time to time).
  9. No TA/DA will be admissible to the candidate for joining as TGT.
  10. If at any time during the course of their temporary appointment, they desire to resign, then in such eventuality, they shall be required to give one month's notice or forfeit, in lieu thereof, their one month's salary including allowances etc.
  11. If they gets an appointment as TGT on the basis of their furnishing ineligible/invalid qualifications, false/forged or fraudulent information/ facts which are detected later on, they would be liable for termination of service without any notice.
  12. This appointment letter is purely provisional subject to providing a duly signed undertaking, verification of character and antecedents of the candidate concerned as well as any other documents deemed necessary for appointment, however, it should be got verified within stipulated period as per CS Haryana instructions no. 52/06/2018-2HR/III dated 05.02.2024. This relaxation does not confer any right to a candidate to remain in job, if subsequently anything adverse is found in verification process as stated above or is reported against him/her at later stage as mentioned in Government Instruction No. 52/08/2002-3GS-III dated 23.06.2022 and instruction No. 52/06/2018-2HR-III dated 05.02.2024.
