SUBJECT: - NOTIFICATION FOR MUKHYAMANTRI SAKSHAM SCHOLARSHIP SCHEME FOR MERITORIOUS STUDENTS.

OBJECTIVE OF THE SCHEME

The Mukhyamantri Saksham Scholarship Scheme for Meritorious Students is hereby framed proposes to increase the availability of purely merit based Scholarships for Government School students of classes 6th to 12th in the State of Haryana.

The objective of the Scholarship scheme is to motivate more and more students to become High Achievers in the State, which will be achieved by:

- Making the Scholarship aspirational and encouraging healthy competition among students
- Increasing the Scholarships available to students and hence, motivate them to obtain this Scholarship

ELIGIBILITY AND SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT FOR ELEMENTARY CLASSES

Applications for the Mukhyamantri Saksham Scholarship Scheme for Meritorious Students will open after each academic year on portal.

Shortlisting of students in Class 6th for the Scholarship will take place over 2 stages: Stage I - Basis the results of SAT exam in Class 5th, students will be eligible to sit for a special competitive exam which will be conducted by the SCERT Haryana, Gurugram. The exam will be based on the NMMS (National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship) exam framework. The exam will include two sections with 30 to 40 multiple choice questions in each:

- Scholastic Ability Test (SAT)
- Mental Ability Test (MAT)

Syllabus for the Grade 6th scholarship exams will include the entire syllabus of Grades 5th. The exam will be conducted at District level. It is recommended that the Haryana Board take over the logistics of conducting the exam given their considerable experience of doing the same for other similar State wide scholarship exams, such as NMMS and NTSE.

The Expenditure of exam will be borne by Academic Cell from the expenditure of SAT/MAT exam.

Results Processing

Results will be processed by SCERT and released to the Academic Cell for compilation of the final list of scholarship awardees.

Stage II – Students ranking in the top 1,500 basis their score in the competitive exam will receive the Scholarship for three years in Classes 6th to 8th, provided that they maintain their SAT result over 80% in classes 6th and 7th.

At the beginning of each new academic year, students in Class 6th will submit their final SAT exam report card for Class 5ththrough an online portal or manually for showing their eligibility to sit for the competitive Scholarship exam. Respective DEEOs will verify the applications of all students and a final list of students qualifying to sit for the competitive Scholarship exam will be published by the Department of School Education. After conduct of the competitive Scholarship exam, a list of students with their exam score and State rank will be published by the Department of School Education. Students with the top 1500 ranks will be allotted the Scholarship.

Table-I shows the details of student eligibility and selection as well as Scholarship amount for elementary classes (6^{th} to 8^{th}).

ELIGIBILITY AND SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT FOR SECONDARY CLASSES

Applications for the Mukhyamantri Saksham Scholarship Scheme for Meritorious Students will open after each academic year.

Classes 9th and 10th

Shortlisting of students in Class 9th for the Scholarship will take place over 2 stages:

Stage I – Basis the results of SAT exam in Class 8th, students will be eligible to sit for a special competitive exam which will be conducted by the SCERT Haryana, Gurugram The exam will be based on the NMMS (National Means-cum-Merit Scholarship) exam framework. The exam will include two sections with 30 to 40 multiple choice questions in each:

- Scholastic Ability Test (SAT)
- Mental Ability Test (MAT)

Syllabus for the Grade 9th scholarship exams will include the entire syllabus of Grades 8th. The exam will be conducted at District level. It is recommended that the Haryana Board take over the logistics of conducting the exam given their considerable experience of doing the same for other similar State wide scholarship exams, such as NMMS and NTSE.

The Expenditure of exam will be borne by Academic Cell from the expenditure of SAT/MAT exam.

Results Processing

Results will be processed by SCERT and released to the Academic Cell for compilation of the final list of scholarship awardees.

Stage II – Students ranking in the top 1,500 basis their score in the competitive exam will receive the Scholarship for two years in Classes 9th to 10th, provided that they maintain their SAT result over 80% in class 9th.

At the beginning of each new academic year, students in Class 9th will submit their final SAT exam report card for Class 8th through an online portal or manually for showing their eligibility to sit for the competitive Scholarship exam. Respective DEOs will verify the applications of all students and a final list of students qualifying to sit for the competitive Scholarship exam will be published by the Department of School Education. After conduct of the competitive Scholarship exam, a list of students with their exam score and State rank will

be published by the Department of School Education. Students with the top 1,500 ranks will be awarded the Scholarship.

Table-II shows the details of student eligibility and selection as well as Scholarship amount for secondary classes (9^{th} to 10^{th}).

Classes 11th and 12th

Shortlisting of students in Class 11th for the Scholarship will be basis the results of Class 10th Haryana Board exams. Students of Class 11th scoring above 95% in Class 10th Board exams and ranking in the top 1000 Government school students in the State will receive the Scholarship for two years in Classes 11th to 12th, provided that they maintain their SAT result over 80% in class 11th.

After the release of Class 10th Board results, students in Class 11th will submit their 10th Board exam mark sheet through an online portal or manually for showing their eligibility to receive the Scholarship. Respective DEOs will verify the applications of all students and a final list of students with their Class 10th Board exam score and State rank will be published by the Department of School Education. Students with the top 1,000 ranks will be awarded the Scholarship.

Table-III shows the details of student eligibility and selection as well as Scholarship amount for secondary classes (11th to 12th).

Post Class 12th

Shortlisting of students passing Class 12th for the Scholarship will be basis the results of Class 12th Haryana Board exams. Students scoring above 95% in Class 12th Board exams and ranking in the top 500 Government school students in the State will receive a one time Scholarship award.

After release of Class 12th State Board results, students passing Class 12th will submit their 12th State Board exam mark sheet through an online portal or manually for showing their eligibility to receive the Scholarship. Respective DEOs will verify the applications of all students and a final list of students with their Class 12th Board exam score and State rank will be published by the Department of School Education. Students with the top 500 ranks will be awarded the Scholarship.

Table-IV shows the details of student eligibility and selection as well as Scholarship amount for secondary classes (post Class 12th).
