Prayer in the present petition is for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioners and to issue the Tamra Patra and other benefits which were admissible to the petitioner for active participation in the protests during the emergency period, under the Government of Haryana State Notifications 2015 and 2017.

Learned State counsel submits that the grievance of the petitioner does not survive any further since the case for release of Tamra Patra has already been processed and that the admissible financial benefits are also being processed for release. The needful shall be done within a period of six weeks.

The present writ petition is accordingly disposed of as having been rendered infructuous on the basis of statement made by the learned State counsel about release of *Tamra Patra* and the financial benefits within a period of 06 weeks as undertaken today.

The respondent-State shall be bound by the statement made today in the Court.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
